





# Early Boats


Early boats were made of wood. They had large sails to catch the wind.

These wooden boats carried goods from place to place.








### **Dhows**

#### Chinese Junks


Junks had crews of up to 130 men.

## Santa Maria


Christopher Columbus was the captain of three ships that sailed to America in 1492. The Santa Maria was the largest ship.


The sailors lived below deck.

Clippers sailed all over the world, carrying goods and passengers.






#### Aircraft Carriers


An aircraft carrier is a huge ship. Planes land on it and take off from it.
