





#### Past Simple V2/Ved

Present Perfect have/has Ved/V3

Past Simple

употребляется с обстоятельствами определенного времени:

yesterday, three days ago, in 1980, just now.

I saw her yesterday.

- Present Perfect
   употребляется с обстоя тельствами неопределен ного, неточного времени:
- recently, lately, of late, for, since, ever, never, just, already, yet.

I haven't seen her for ages.

# Present Perfect Tense (настоящее завершенное время)

• действие, совершившееся в прошлом, но связанное с настоящим I have just made toasts. (They are still hot) -Я только что приготовил тосты. (Они еще горячие).

• подведение своего рода итогов на сегодняшний день
I have never been to China.Я никогда не был в Китае.



## SINCE

с какого-то момента в прошлом до настоящего времени

I haven't heard from him since June.

Я не получал от него известий с июня.

#### с тех пор как

I haven't heard from him since he left Moscow.

Я не получал от него известий с тех пор, как он уехал из Москвы.

## **FOR**


