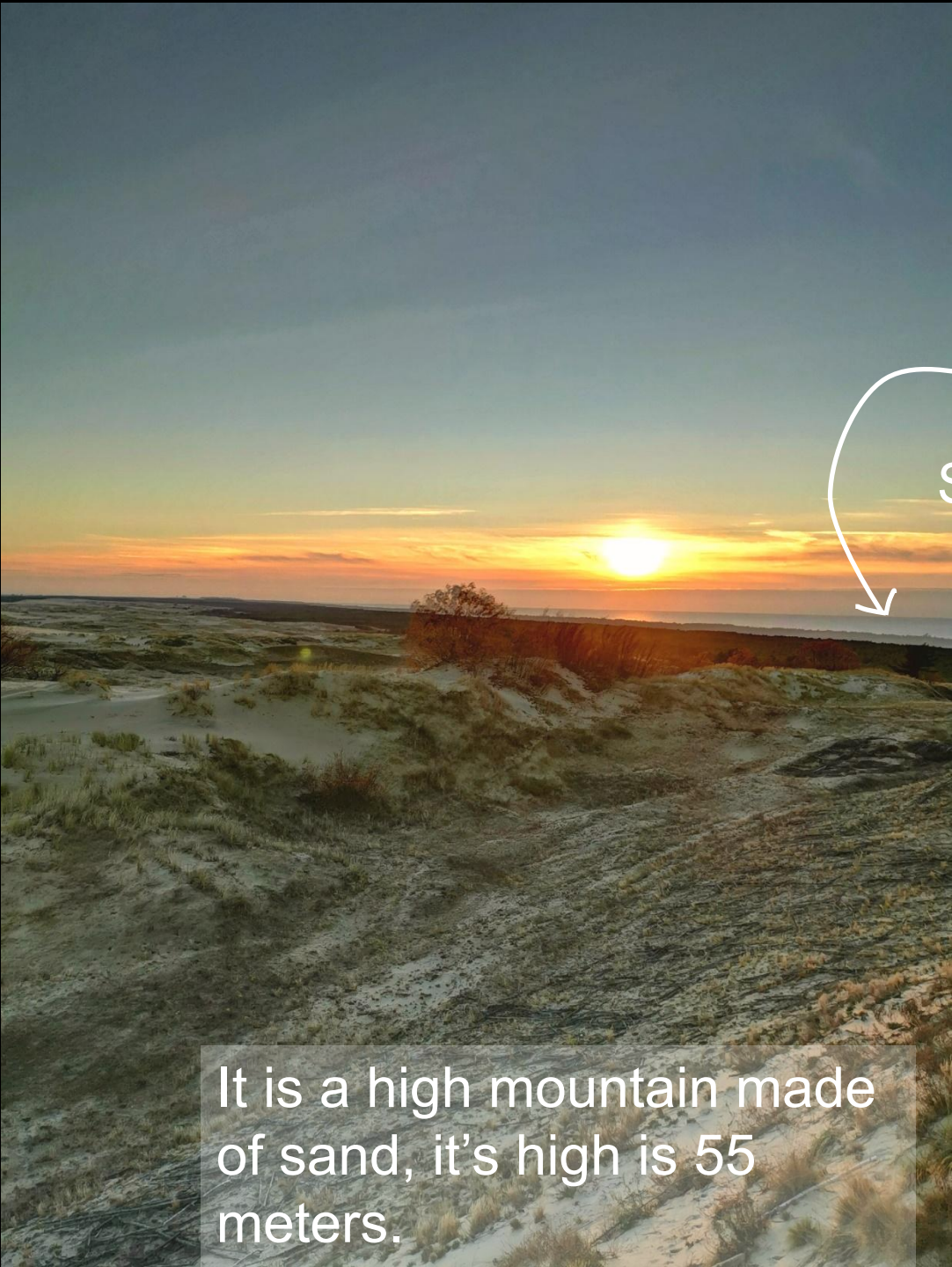
It looks like a magic forest with curved trees. Scientists still argue about the causes of their strange figures.

A fascinating park is located in the north of the city. There is a huge pond and a lot of swans swim there everyday.

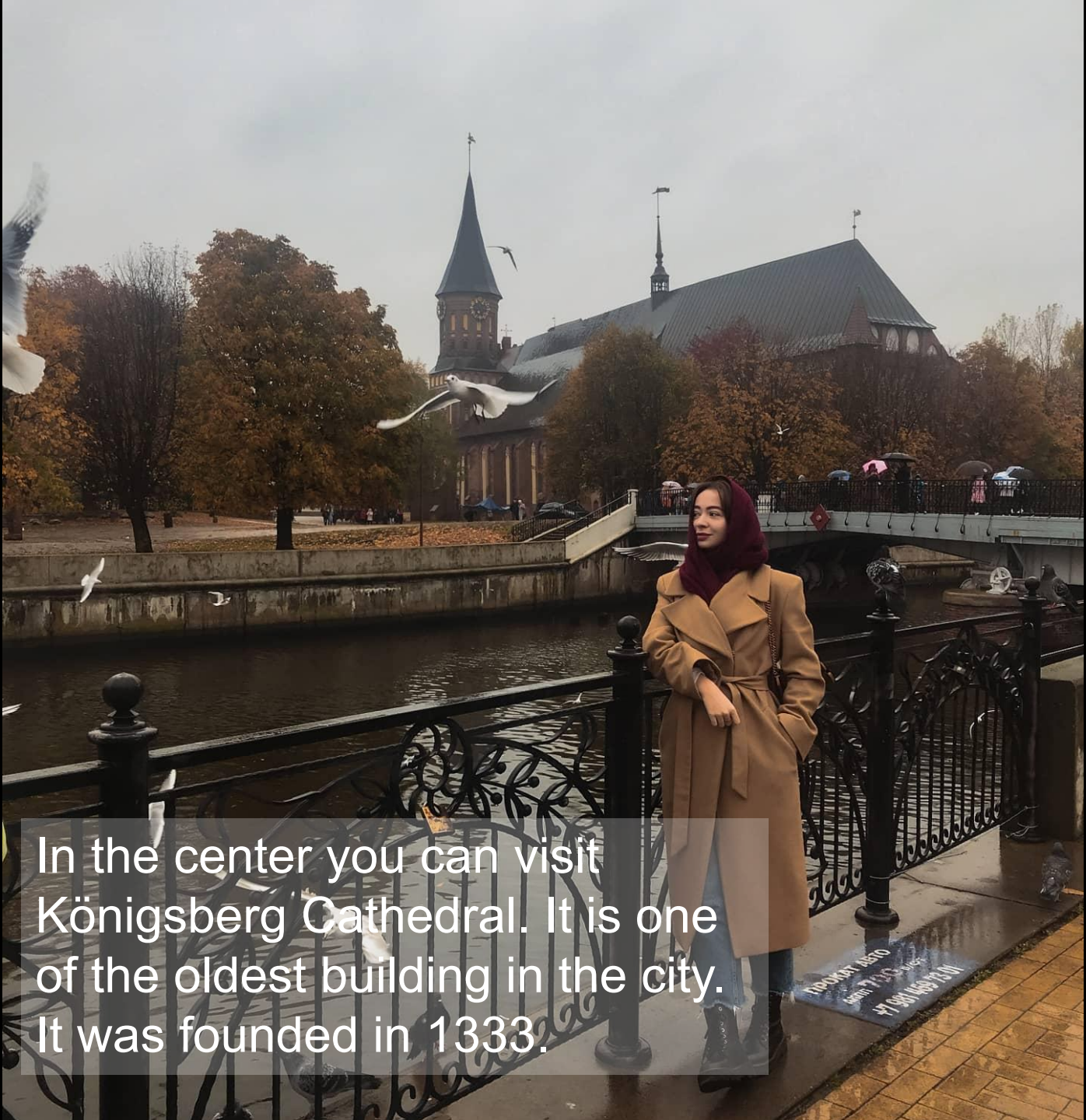
