

Plural of Nouns

1. GENERAL RULE: *REGULAR PLURALS*

SINGULAR NOUN + **S** = **PLURAL** NOUN

EXAMPLES:



car



cars



table



tables



2. Plural of Nouns

SINGULAR NOUNS ENDING IN -CH, -S, -SS, -S, -O, -X + ES = PLURAL NOUN

EXAMPLES:



TOMATO



TOMATOES



FOX



FOXES



3. Plural of Nouns

But **NOUNS OF FOREIGN ORIGIN** ENDING
IN **-O** JUST ADD **-S**

EXAMPLE:



PIANO



PIANOS



4. Plural of Nouns

Singular noun ending in a consonant + -Y
change the -Y to -I + -es = Plural Noun

EXAMPLE:



Country



Countries



Baby



Babies



5. Plural of Nouns

Singular Nouns ending in a vowel + y just add **-s** = Plural Noun

EXAMPLE:



Boy



Boys



6. Plural of Nouns

SINGULAR NOUNS ENDING IN **-F** or **_FE**
change the **-F** or **-FE** to **-VES**.

EXAMPLES:



LEAF



LEAVES



WOLF



WOLVES



Plural of Nouns

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IRREGULAR PLURALS

SOME NOUNS ARE **irregular** AND THEY DON'T FOLLOW THE RULES ABOVE.

EXAMPLES:



mouse



mice



deer



deer

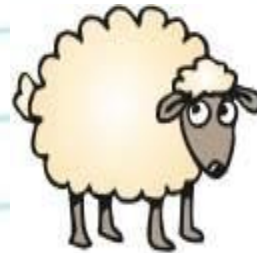

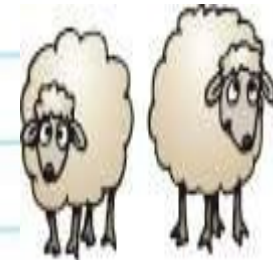
