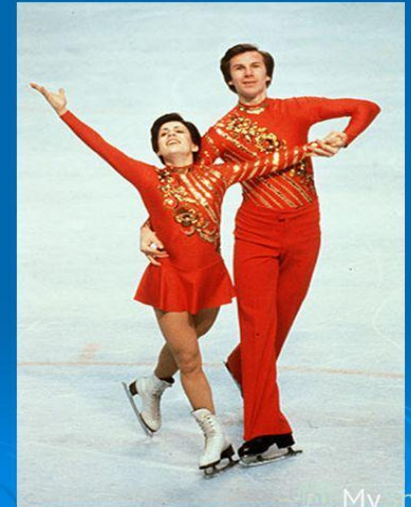
4. The results of the Russian sportsmen in kayaking and canoeing.

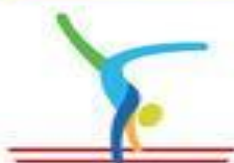

Culture notes

The original Wembley Stadium opened in 1923. It was designed to hold 100,000 people, but for the first big match at the stadium, the 1923 FA Cup Final, it held 200,000–300,000 people. The original stadium building was demolished in 2002 and the new stadium, shown in the photo on page 59, opened in 2007. It is designed to hold 90,000 people and is used for football, rugby and boxing events, as well as non-sporting events such as concerts.

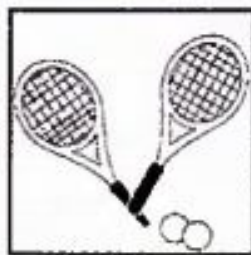

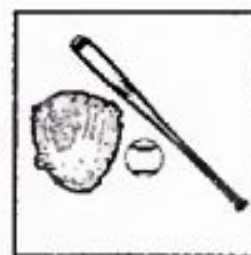
