Conditional Clause	Main Clause
If + Present Simple	Present Simple

- If you **heat** ice, it **melts**
- If we **don't water** plants, they **die**.
- If you **touch** a fire, you **get** burned.

Used to express something which is always true. We can also use *when* instead of *if*.

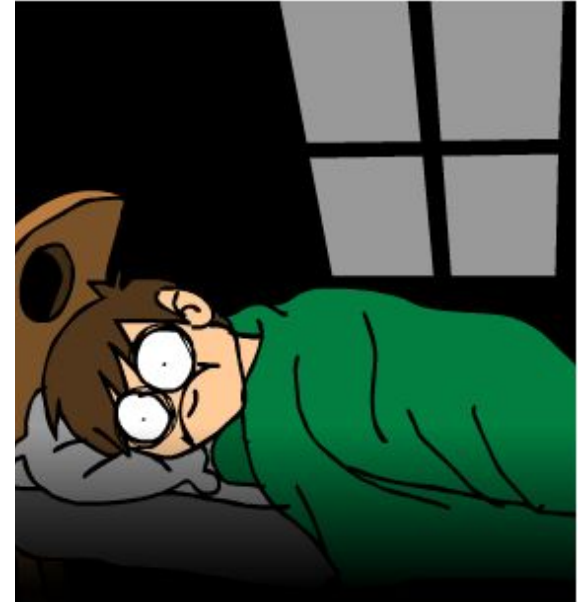

Real/possible/ probable present (first)

If-clause

If + present simple

Main clause

Will + verb

Used to express real or very probable situations in the present or future.

Type 1

Conditional Clause	Main Clause
If + Present Simple	Future Simple

- If you **have** any problems, I'll **try** to help you.
- If it **rains**, I **won't go** to the park.
- If they **play** well, they'll **win** the match
- She'll **miss** the bus if she **doesn't leave** soon.

First Conditionals

Unreal present (second)

If-clause

If + past simple or
past continuous

Main clause

Would + verb

Used to express hypothetical imaginary situations which are contrary to the facts in the present, and therefore, are unlikely to happen in the present or future.

Type 2

Conditional Clause	Main Clause
If + Past Simple	would + Infinitive

- If I **met** the Queen of England, I **would say** hello.
- If I **were** you , I **wouldn't go out** with him.
- She **would travel** all over the world if she **were** rich.
- They **would go** to the beach if it **were** warmer.

If-clause

Unreal past (third)

If-clause

If + past perfect

Main clause

Would have +
participle

Used to express hypothetical imaginary situations which are contrary to the facts in the past. Also used to express regrets or criticism.

Type 3



Conditional Clause	Main Clause
If + Past Perfect	would + Perfect Infinitive (would + have + V3)

- If we **had revised** more, we **would have passed** the test
- He **would have been** on time for the interview if he **had left** the house at nine
- If he **had taken** his umbrella, he **wouldn't have got** wet.

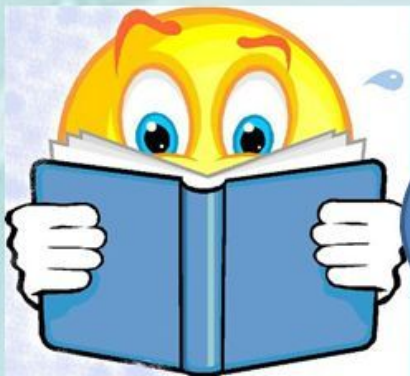
