SYMBOLS of RUSSIA

- One symbol is the Russian national flag. It has three stripes: white, blue and red. These colours have always been symbolic in Russia: white – noble and sincere, blue –honest and devoted, red has always meant love and bravery.
- Another symbol of Russia is the birch tree.



State Emblem of Russia



- The State Emblem of Russia is a golden double-headed eagle, placed on a red heraldic shield, above the eagle - three historical crowns of Peter I. Two small - on each of the heads and one large over two small crowns, in the clutches of an eagle - the scepter and orb; on the breast of an eagle on a red shield - a horseman, slaying the Dragon.

The Russian Federation is the big democracy country. Russia is Presidential Republic. Power in the Russian Federation is divided into three parts: legislative, executive and judicial branches.

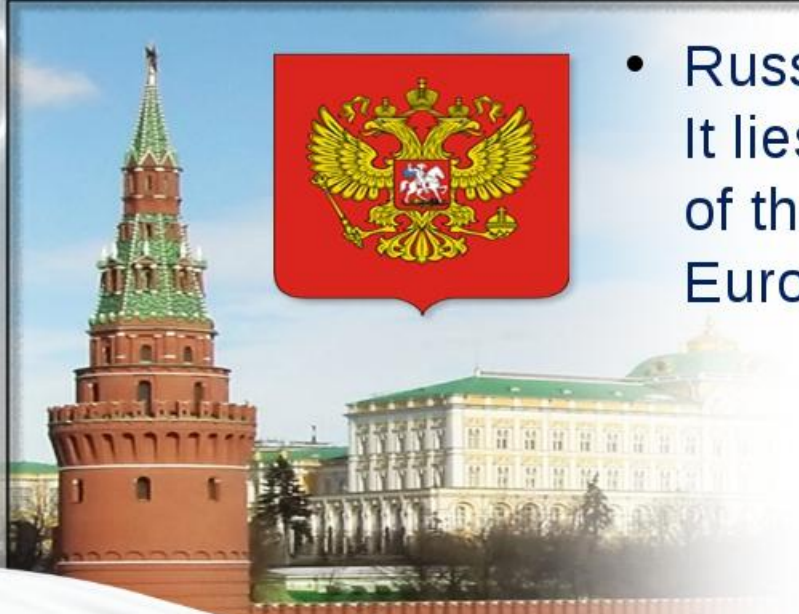
Lake Baikal



Lake Baikal is a rift lake in Russia. It is located in southern Siberia. Lake Baikal is the largest freshwater lake in the world. It is considered among the world's clearest lakes and is considered the world's oldest lake — **at 25 million years.**



Baikal is home to thousands of species of plants and animals, many of which exist nowhere else in the world. The lake was declared a **UNESCO World Heritage Site** in 1996.

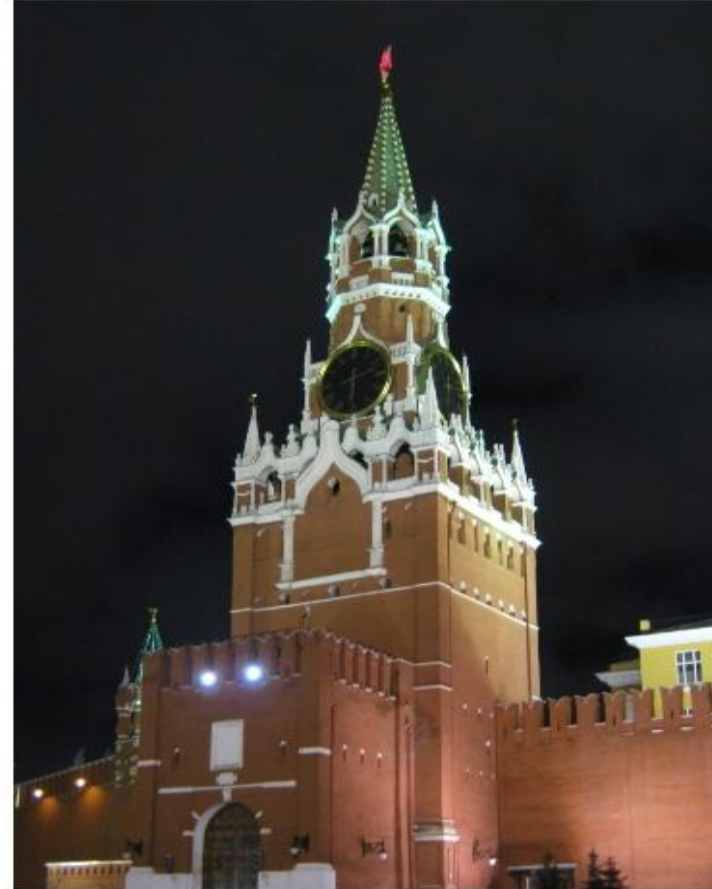


- Russia is the largest country of the world. It lies on a huge territory from the coast of the Pacific Ocean to the center of Europe. Its climate is different.

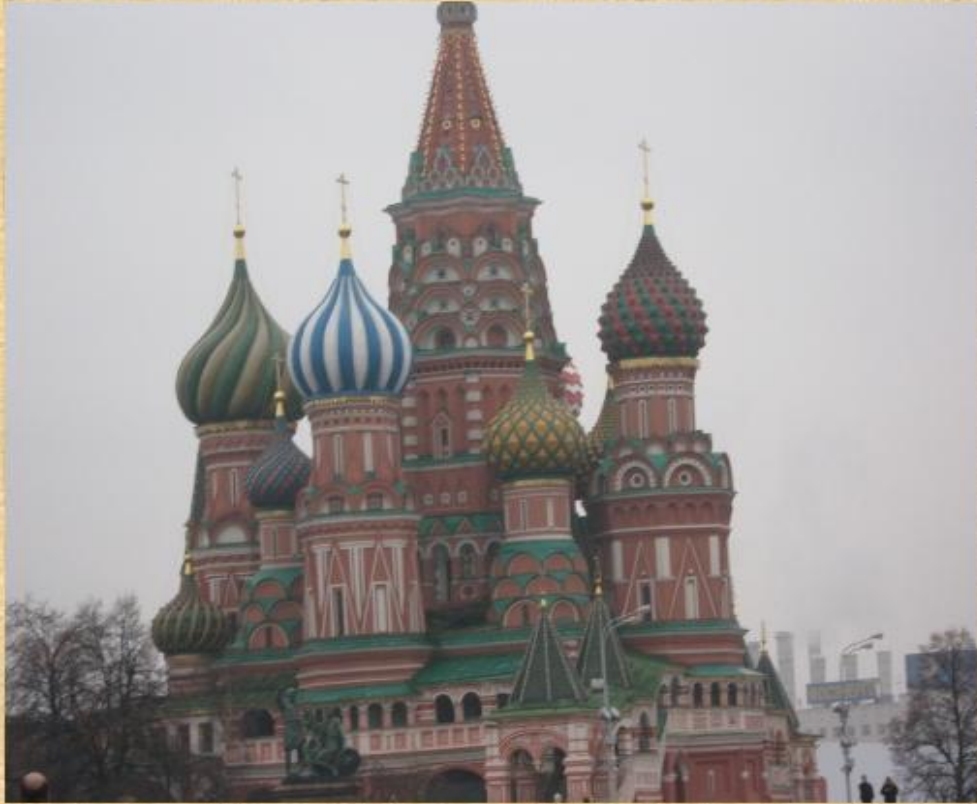


The History of Matryoshka Doll

- The doll looked very Russian and soon became popular.
- The name Matryoshka came from the common Russian name Matryona.

St. Basil Cathedral



St. Basil Cathedral is one of the most outstanding monuments of Old Russian architecture. In the 16th century the tourists admired the beauty of the cathedral, and for the Russians it became the symbol of native history and culture.

St. Basil Cathedral is a symmetrical architectural ensemble consisting of eight chapels surrounding the ninth one.
