

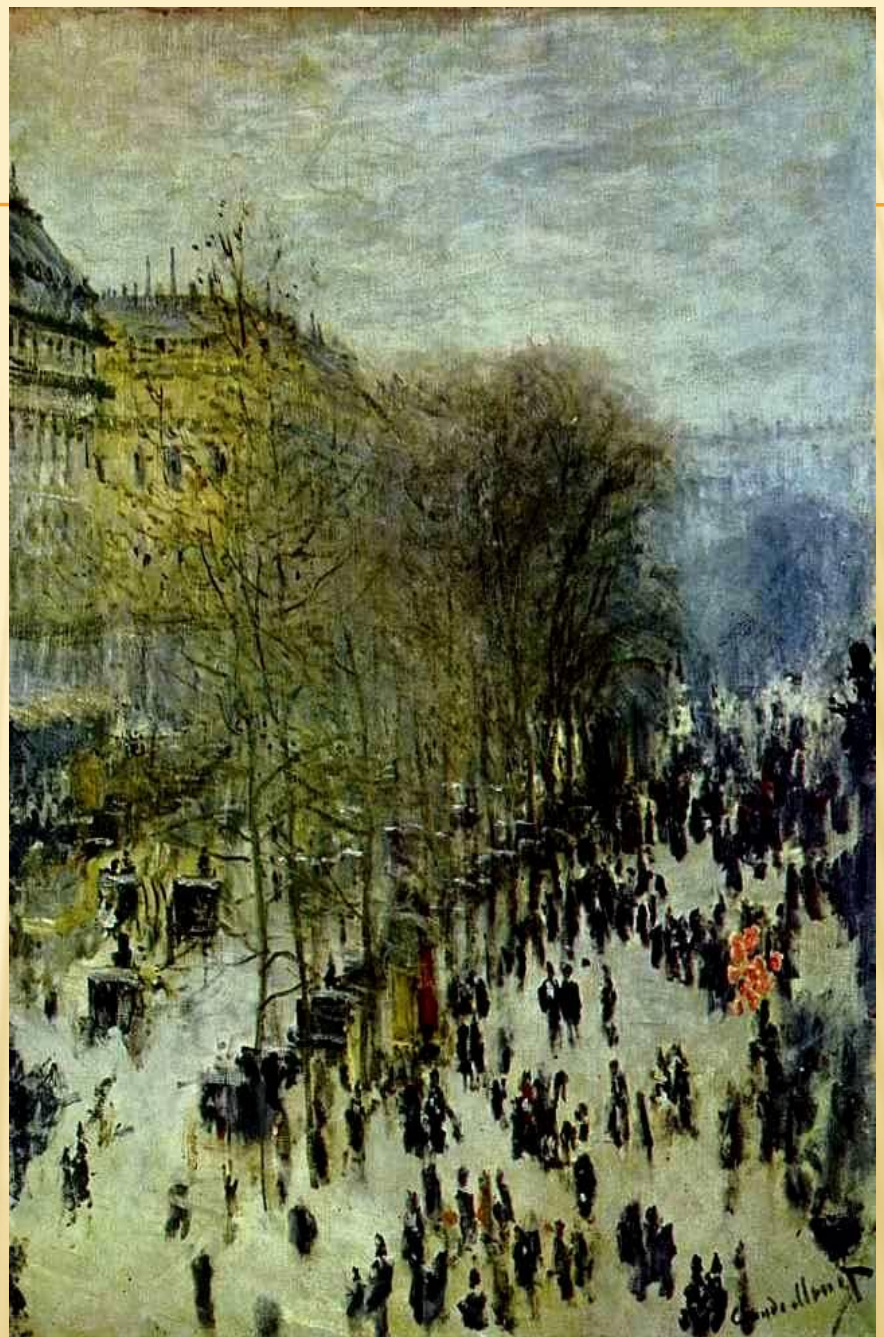

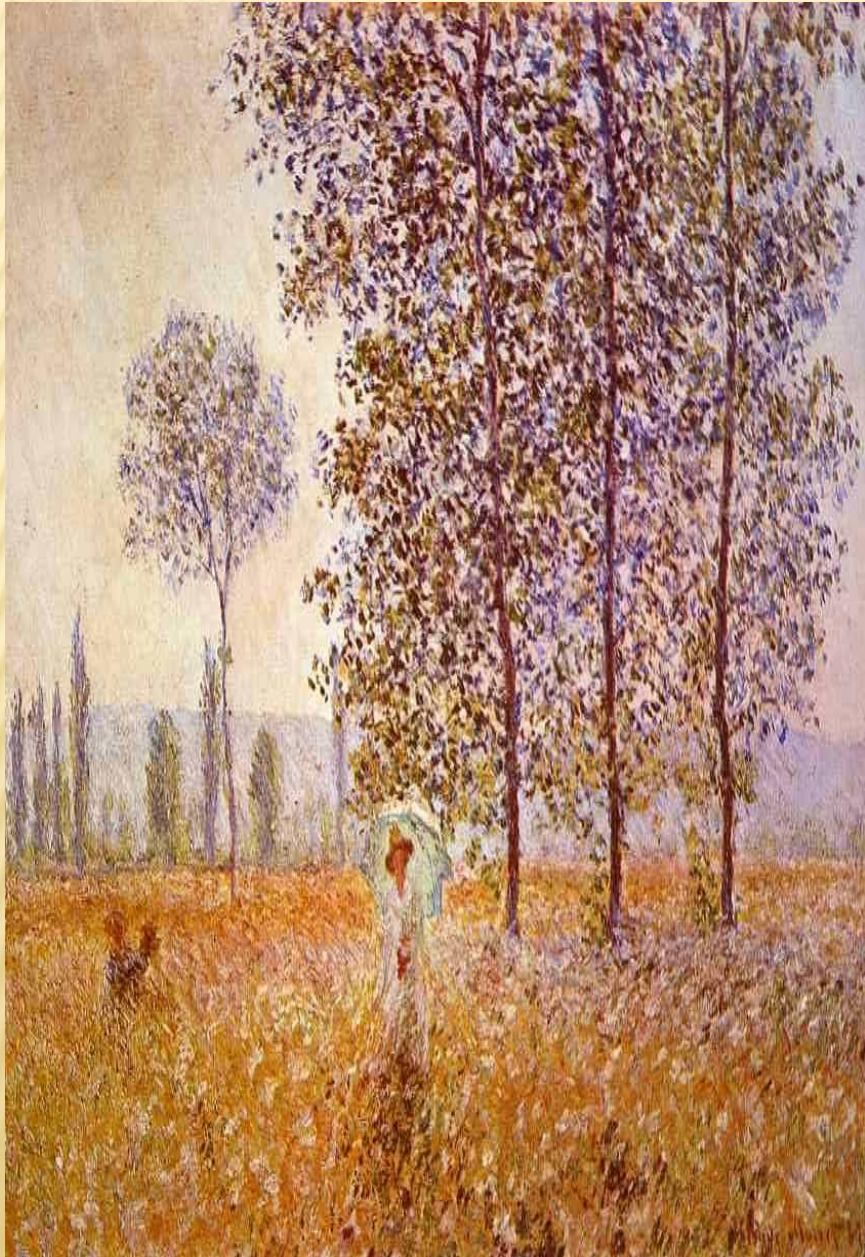

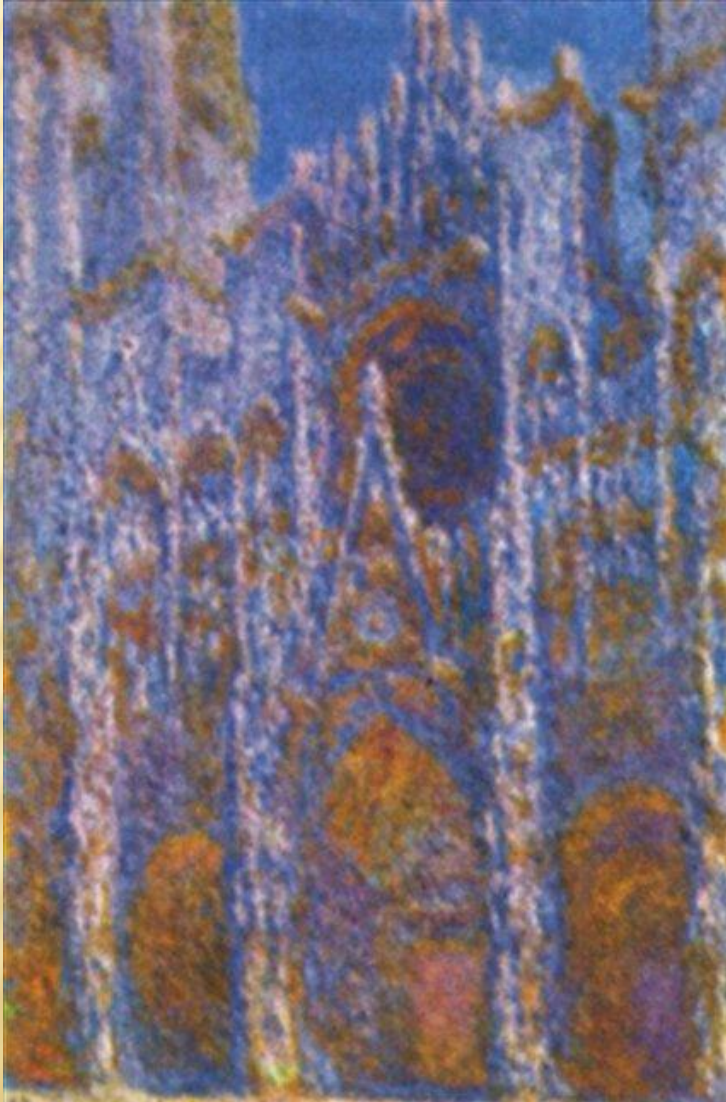


Monet used a special way of colouring. He avoided to mix colours on a palette; he used for instance, for green foliage some yellow and blue, in the distance they merge, "mixed up" in the eye of the Viewer,

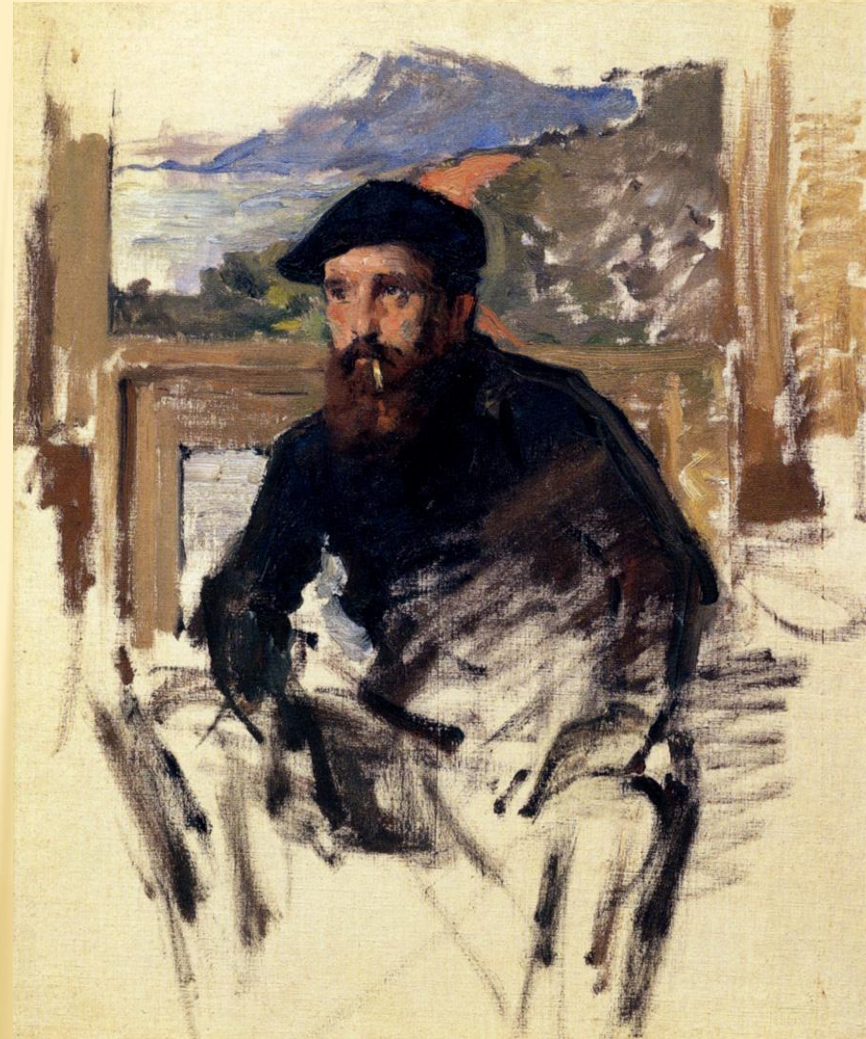
The Rouen Cathedral at noon " The Rouen Cathedral in the evening "
