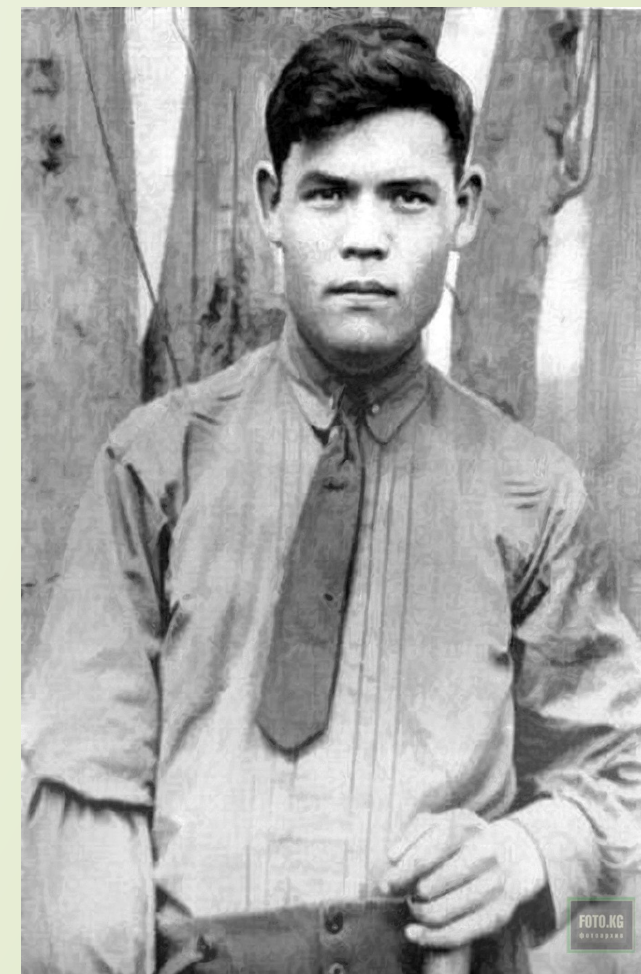




Ahunbaev Isa Konoevich

- **sphere of activity:** Surgeon
- **period of life:** September 25, 1908 year-January 5, 1975 year. Died at 66-year life in the Chuy province of Kyrgyzstan.
- **Place of birth:** Russian Empire, Turkestan, village tour-Ajgir (modern name Toru-Aygur village)
- **nationality:** Kyrgyz
- **marital status:** Wife-Bibihan Ismailovna Ahunbaeva (maiden name-Ismailov).




Five children: eldest son-**Mustafa** went into art, long time Director of the Opera and Ballet Theatre, Professor Conservatory of music **Nelly**, m.d., Professor of surgery at the Hospital of the medical faculty of the Kyrgyz-Slavonic University, Rossiskogothe first prize winner academician Isa Ahunbaeva CD, merited doctor;


Chinara is a doctor, was preparing to defend his doctoral dissertation, but died along with his father;

Anara-teacher of Russian language and literature at a University;

Meder-cardiac surgeon, he defended two dissertations, died in 52 years.

 - 1961-Started surgical activities. Its main works are devoted to the study of endemic goitre in children, appendicitis and hydatidosis.
 - literature: He was one of the editors of a number of medical journals, including Breast Surgery, Endocrinology Problems, Circulation, and Healthcare of Kyrgyzstan.

- September 25, 2008 - By the Decree of the President of the Kyrgyz Republic, the Kyrgyz State Medical Academy was named after Academician Isa Konoevich Akhunbayev.
