# Present Simple (настоящее простое время)

- Действие, которое происходит всегда, часто, постоянно.
- I/you/we/they/сущ. во мн.ч. + глагол

*I **play** tennis every day*

# Present Simple (настоящее простое время)

- He /she/ it/ сущ. в ед. ч. + глагол (**s/es**)

She play**s** tennis every day.

Verb + -es		
• do	➔	does
• go	➔	goes
• wash	➔	washes
• watch	➔	watches

# Present Simple (настоящее простое время)

- Like + глагол (ing)

I like playing tennis.

She likes playing tennis.

# Present Simple negative

- I/you/we/they/сущ. во мн.ч. + **do not (don't)**  
+ глагол

*They **don't** play tennis every day*

- He /she/ it/ сущ. в ед. ч. + **does not (doesn't)**  
+ глагол

*She **plays** tennis every day.*

*She **doesn't** play tennis every day.*

*Do they **play** tennis every day?*

- **Does** + he /she/ it/ сущ. в ед. ч.+ глагол

*She **plays** tennis every day.*

*Does she **play** tennis every day?*

No, she **doesn't.**

# Модальный глагол have to

- **Have to/ has to** – вынужден, приходится
- Выражает значение обязанности или необходимости
- I **have to** get up early every day.
- She **has to** wear a uniform.

# Отрицательные предложения

- don't have to
- doesn't have to
- I \_\_\_\_\_ get up early
- She \_\_\_\_\_ wear a uniform

# Вопросительные предложения
