*They **didn't bring** the textbook.*

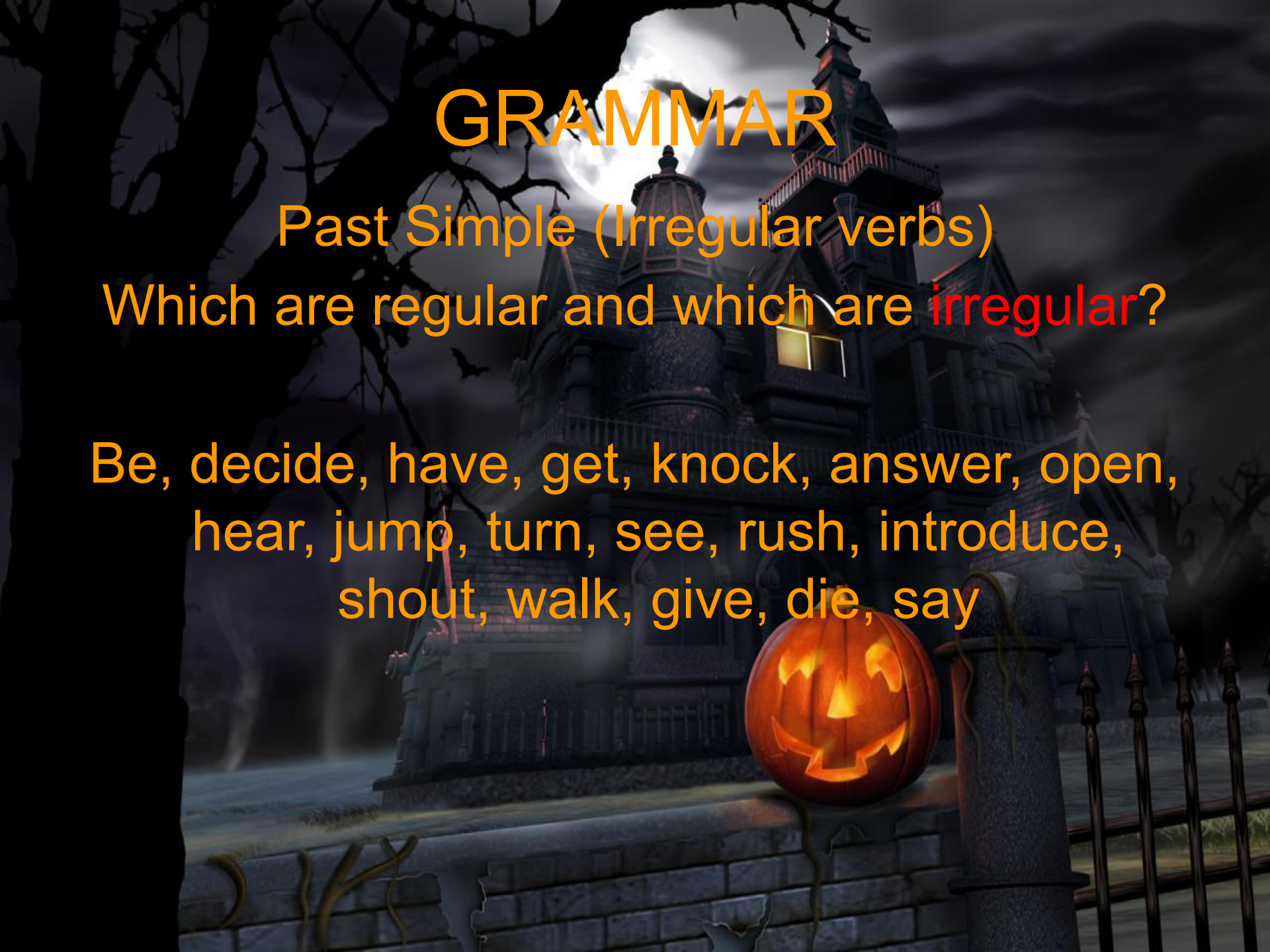
***Did** you **go** to your aunt's on Saturday?*
