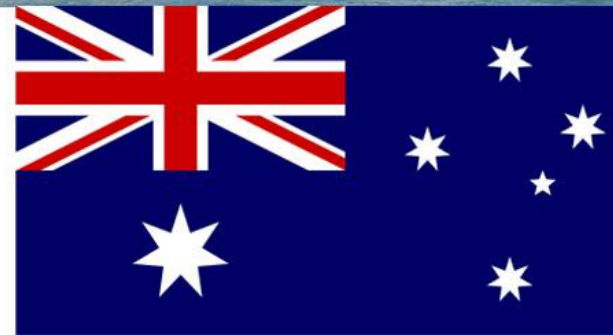

Australia is an island continent and the world's sixth largest country 7,682,300 sq km.Canberra is Australia's capital city.A federal parliamentary constitutional monarchy, comprising six states and ten territories.

The Australian environment ranges from virtually pristine Antarctic territory and rainforests to degraded industrial areas of major cities. Forty distinct ecoregions have been identified across the Australian mainland and islands.

Before the arrival of the British colonialists in 1788, Australia was inhabited by indigenous peoples-aborigines. Today, indigenous peoples make up 2.4% of the total population of Australia. 24 million people. The country's vast openness means it has the lowest population density in the world - only two people per square kilometre.
