MODALS

Visitors **can take** photos.

Photos **can be taken**.

We use the **passive**:

- when the person who carries out the action is unknown, unimportant or obvious from the context. *The Terracotta Army **is located** in China.*
- to make statements more formal or polite.

*Taking photos in the museum **is prohibited**.*

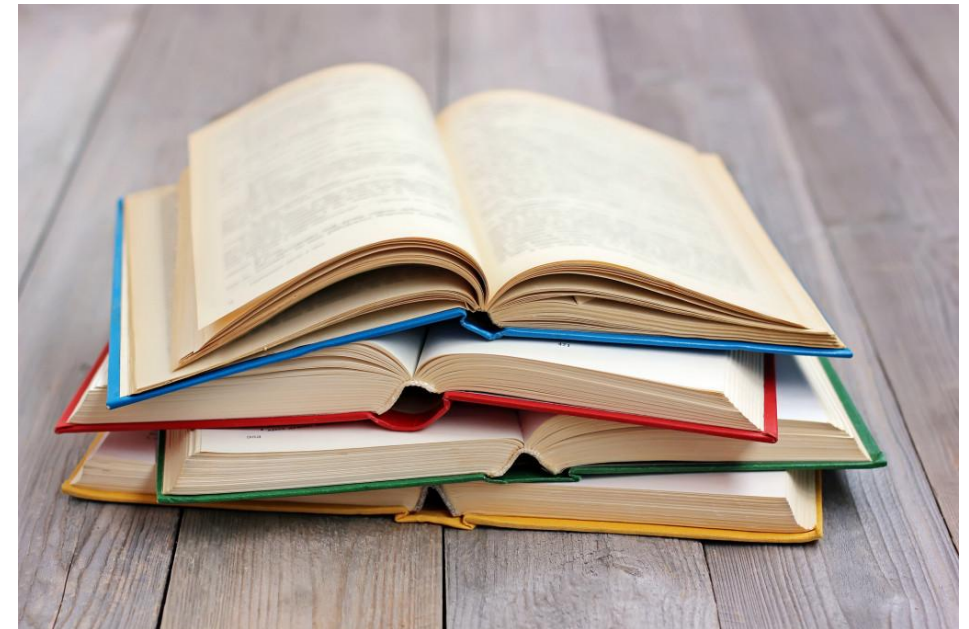

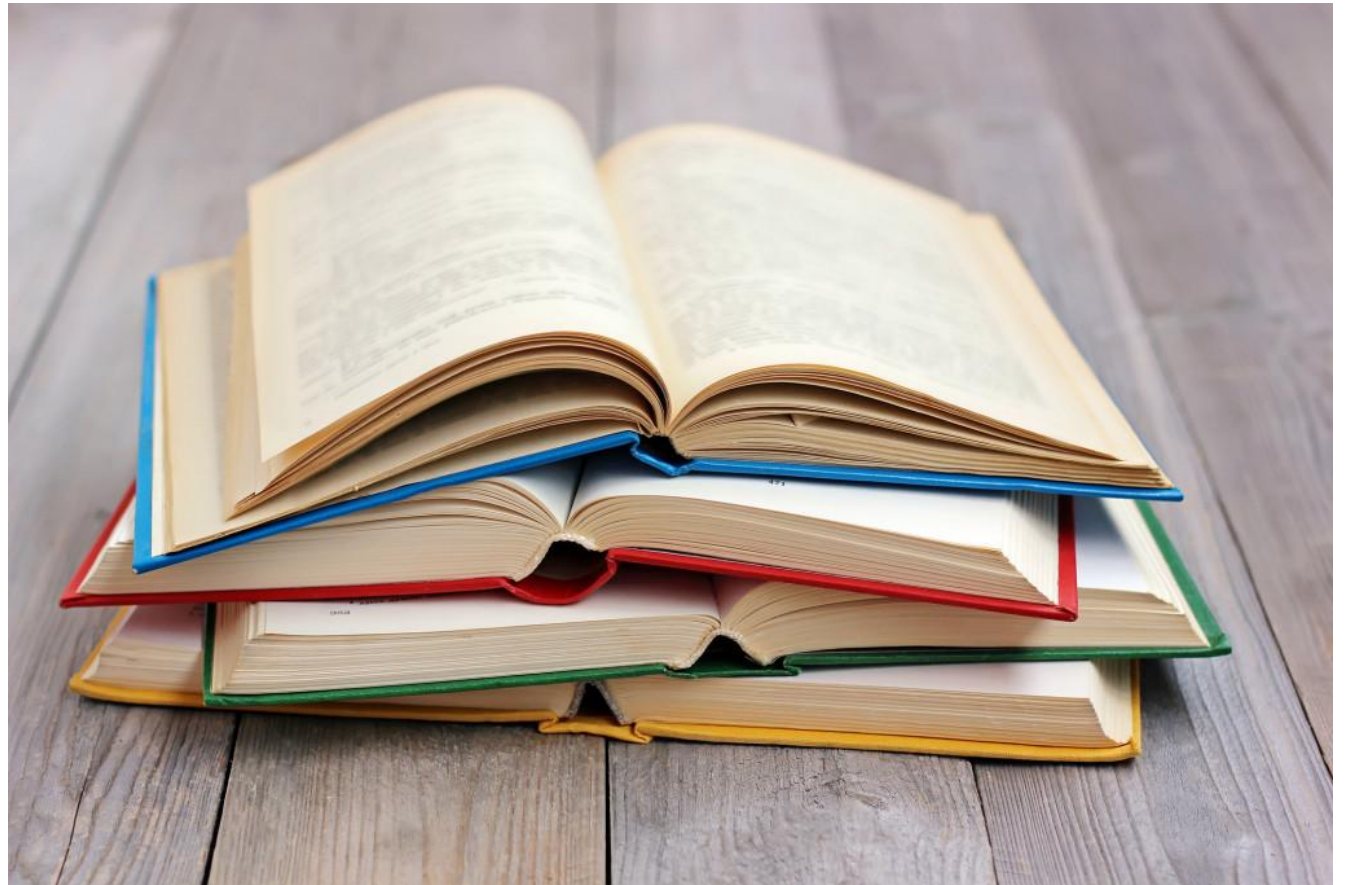
