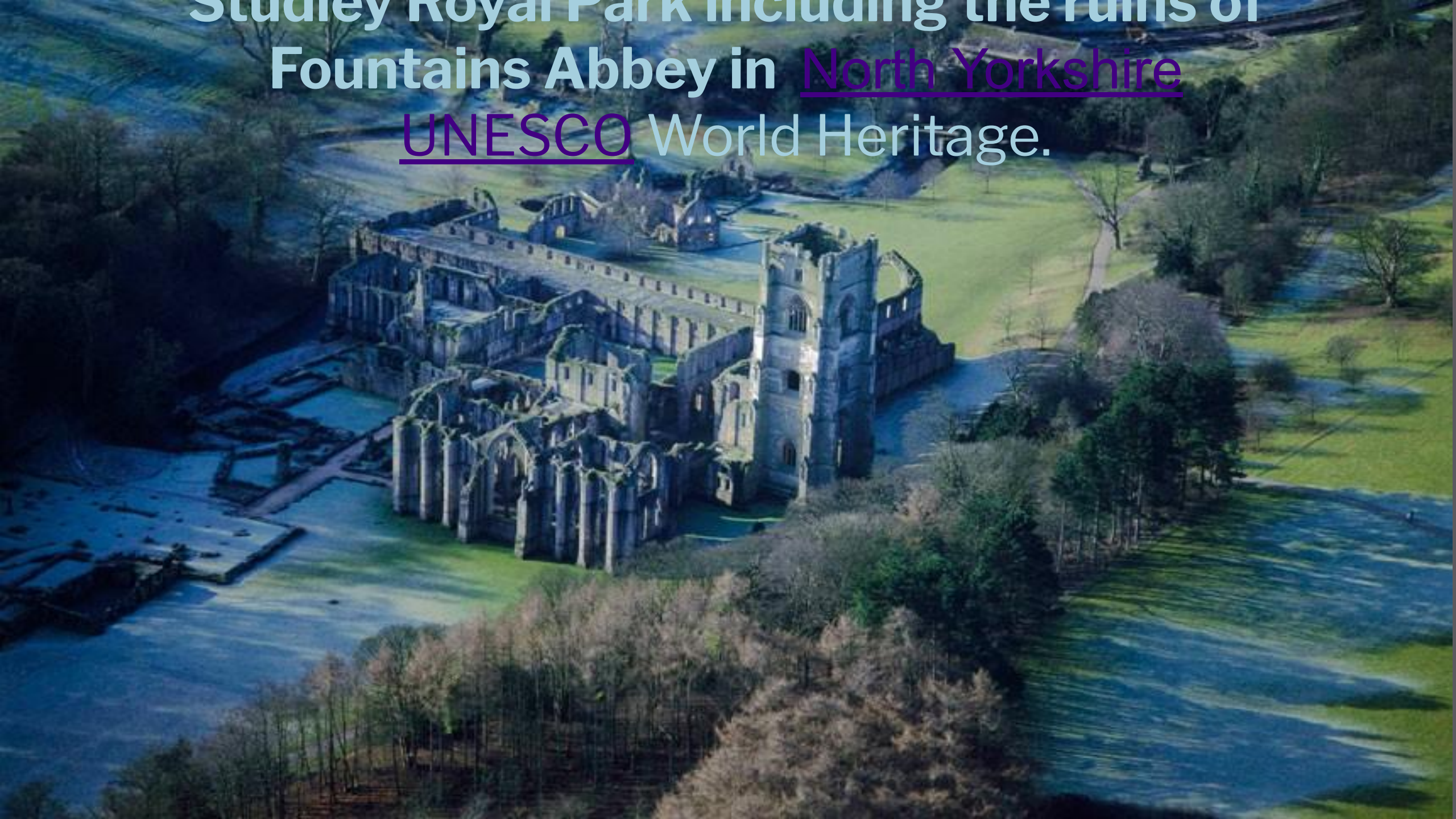


Bass Rock Island is situated in 1,5 kilometers off
