For example: <u>All</u> of my shoes are worn out. Use <u>each</u> when you think about people or things in a group separately. It's more usual for a small number. It's followed by a singular verb.

For example: She had a bottle in <u>each</u> hand.

every

Use <u>every</u> when you think about the whole group of people or things together. It's more usual for a large number. It's followed by a singular verb.

For example: <u>Every</u> student was given a prize.
