she <b>has</b> tidied	she <b>hasn't</b> tidied	<b>Has</b> she tidied	her room
it <b>has</b> eaten	it <b>hasn't</b> eaten	<b>Has</b> it eaten	all food
you <b>have</b> watched	you <b>haven't</b> watched	<b>Have</b> you watched	a new film
they <b>have</b> read	they <b>haven't</b> read	<b>Have</b> they read	this book
