


It's a round, striped, rubber ball.




It's a rectangular, plain, leather wallet.



It's a square, polka-dot, plastic bag.




It's a square, striped, velvet cushion.




## Idioms and sayings about food

saying N a sentence that people often say and that gives advice or information about human life and experience


