Community health centers



Community health centers are clinics that are supported by the federal government, specifically the Health Resources and Services Administration (HRSA). In order to be supported by HRSA, these clinics must do the following:

- be located in a high-need area
- provide comprehensive primary care services
- supply additional resources to help promote better health, such as education, translation, and transportation services
- adjust the cost of care based on an individual's ability to pay
- be directed by a community board
- meet other specific clinical, financial, and administrative requirements

In addition to providing primary care, a community health center may also provide access to other health-related resources. These can include pharmacies, dental care, and mental health services.

- Of course! In most European countries all Americans need is a valid US driver's license and passport to rent a car in Europe. - All Auto Europe Car Rentals include liability and fire insurance at no extra cost. Liability insures against any damage done to anything outside of the rental car while fire insurance protects against mechanical fires. More comprehensive coverage typically includes a Collision Damage Waiver (CDW) insuring damage done to the rental car in the event of an accident and Theft Protection to cover the loss if the rental vehicle is stolen while you are in Europe. When renting a car in Italy it is required renters purchase CDW and Theft Protection in their insurance plan. Check with your reservation agent what is required in your destination.
