

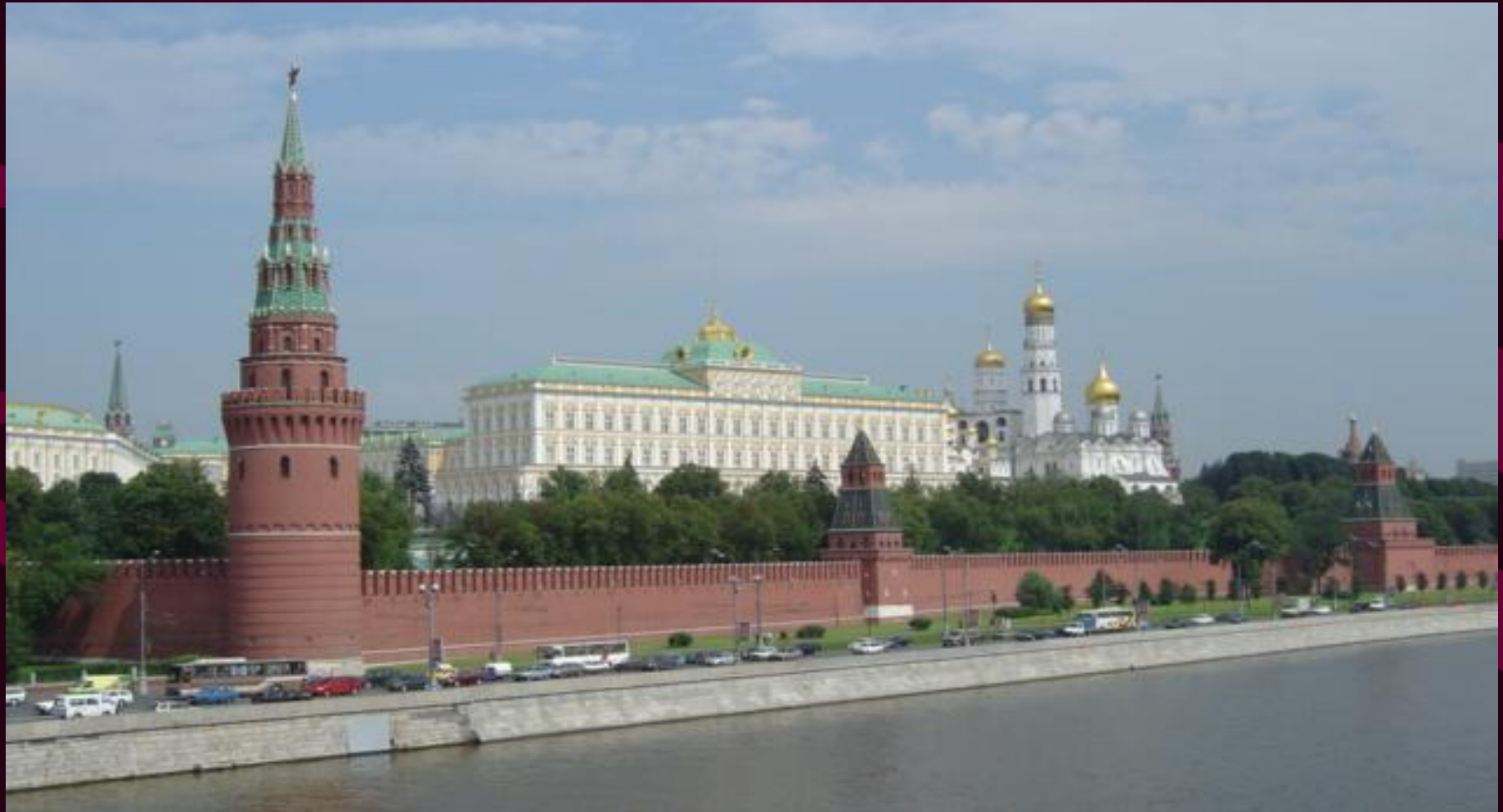

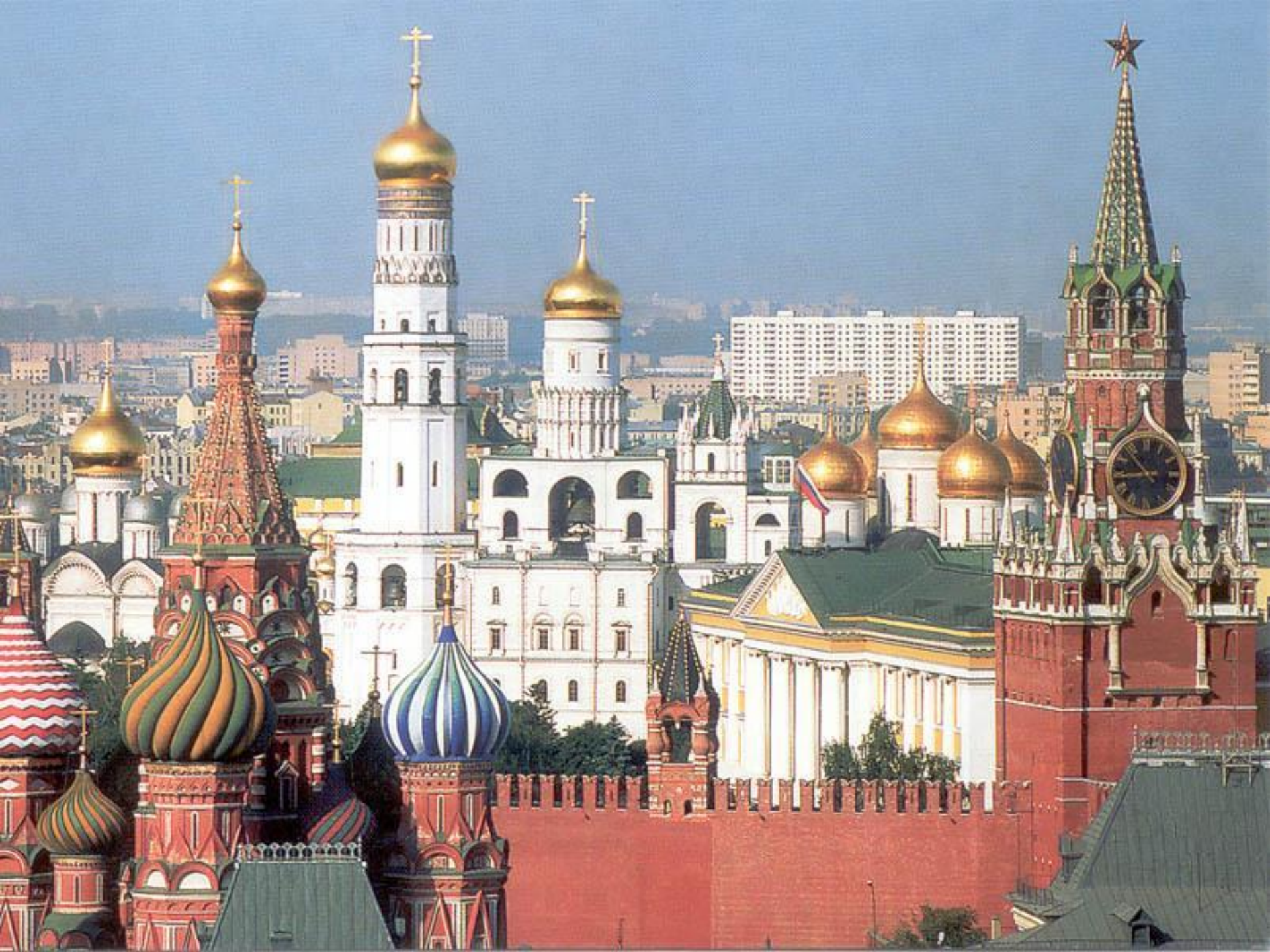
Moscow is the capital of Russia, its political, industrial and cultural centre. The city is situated on the Moskva-river. The population of Moscow is over 10 mln people.



Moscow has a long history. Great Prince Yuri Dolgoruky founded it 860 years ago in 1147. In the 16th century Moscow became the capital of Russian state.







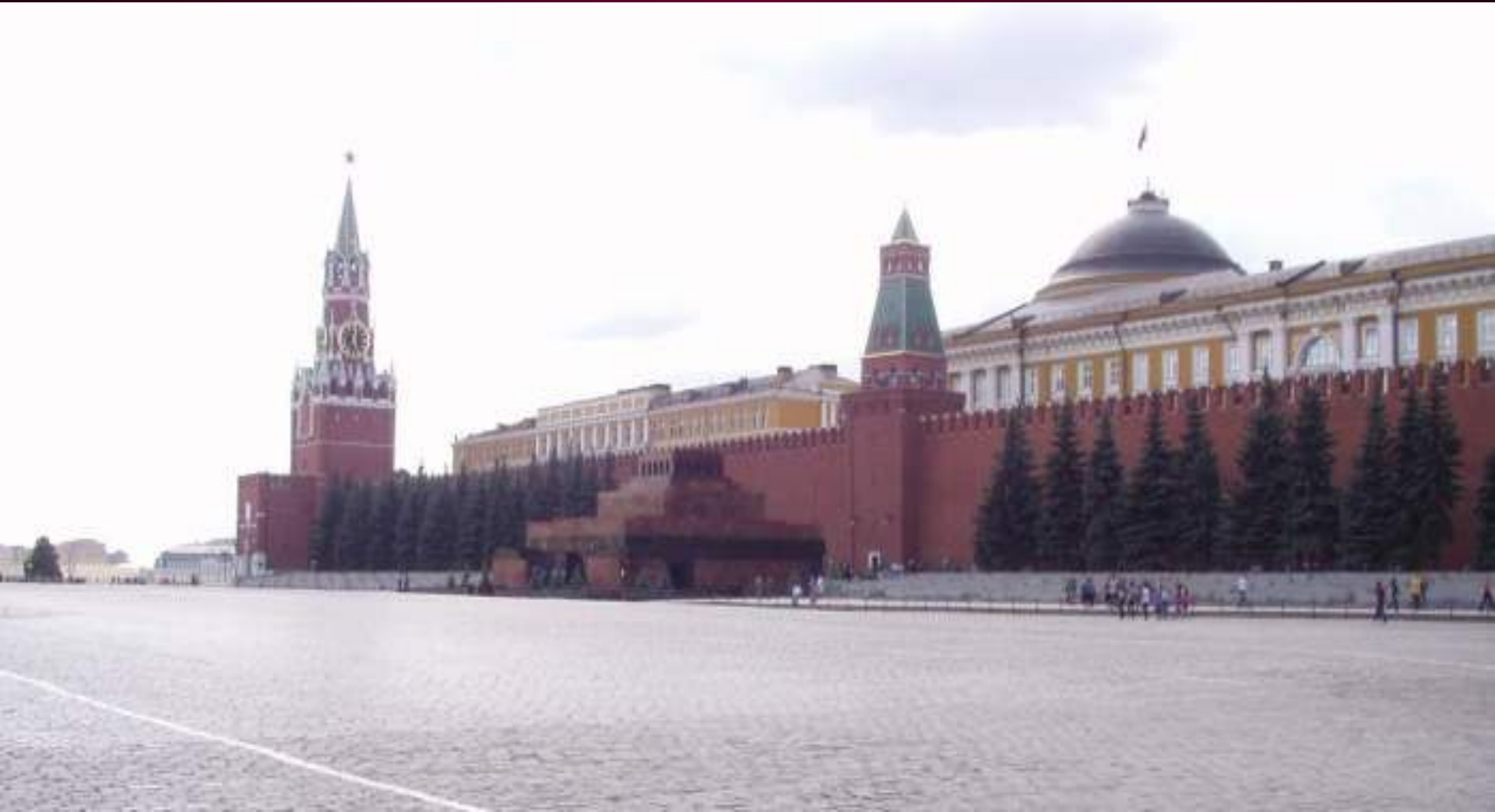
