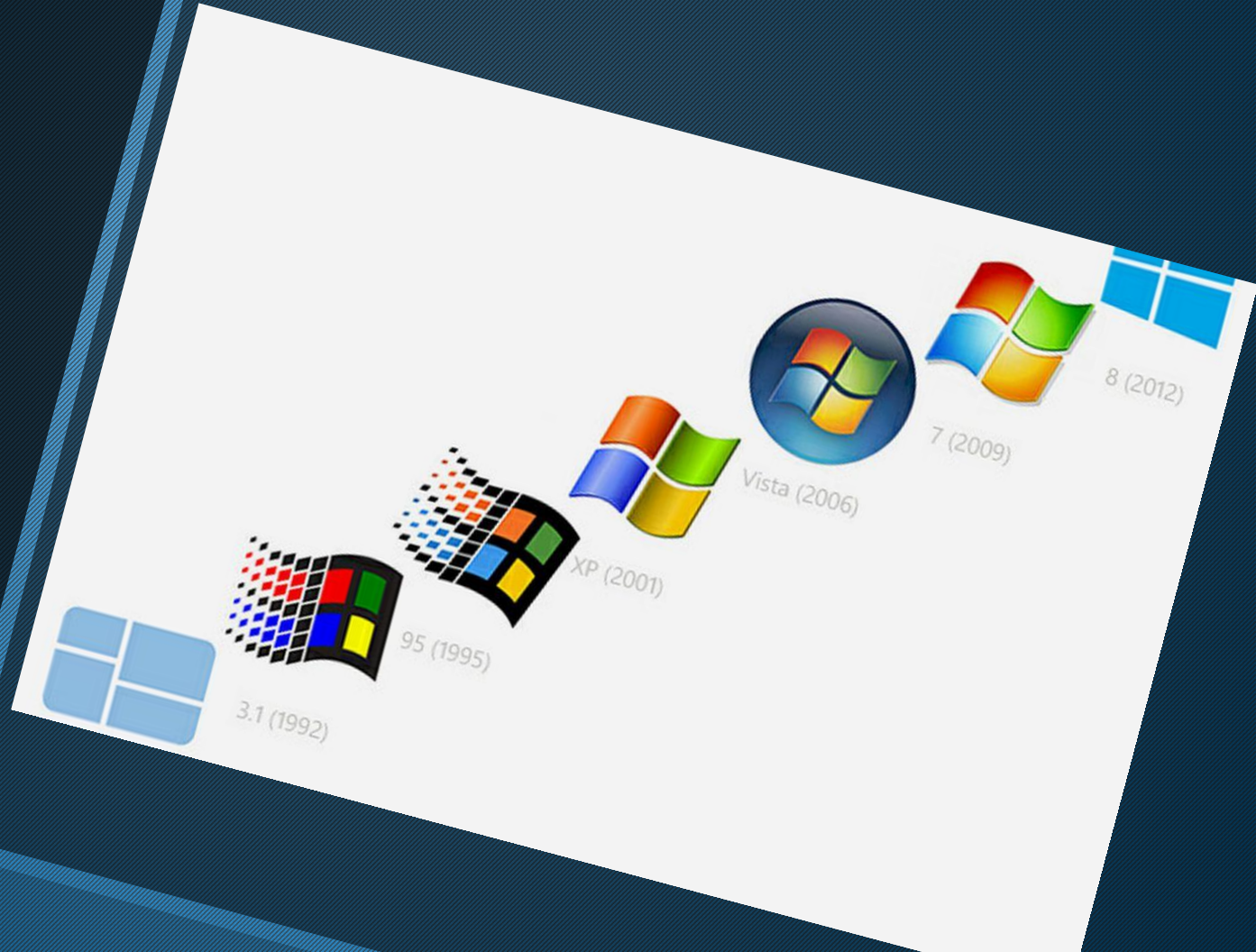
- At 15, he wrote a program for traffic control together, and earned \$ 20,000.
