- Mark Zuckerberg did not complete higher education: in 2002, he entered Harvard University, where until 2004 he studied at the Department of Psychology.
- Back in college, Microsoft employees noticed Mark after writing the Synapse program, which allowed the computer to independently compose a sequence of music hits for its owner.

Facebook

- Together with Chris Hughes and Dustin Moskowitz began to create a social network Facebook . Financial assistance was provided by a student of Brazilian origin, Eduardo Saverin.
- Mark does not have a higher education, he achieved such heights thanks to ambition, talent and daily hard work. A young man is an example of how to achieve success without a diploma, if you go to your goal and make every effort to achieve it.
- When Zuckerberg created a social network, he solved the problem that he saw around him and did not plan to create a business. Four years after the establishment of the network, Zuckerberg was still trying to help people connect with each other.

Income

- Today, the market capitalization of a social network exceeds \$ 500 billion, the social network itself has more than 2 billion active users per month. And the status of the founder of the social network exceeds \$ 70 billion.
