



Choice and freedom

- Transferring to another university is simple
- Curriculum can be customized, you can select professors, electives and subjects
- Suitable for students, that want to broaden their knowledge in different subjects

Visa Policy

On campus only: student center, bookstore, cafeteria (to work off-campus you will have to apply for a Curricular Practical Training) Work during studying

Off-campus: 20 hours a week part-time or full-time during holidays
