- ▶ **What is the purpose of green belts?** (The green belt offers in many cases protection to areas of openness, we have behind me areas of natural beauty...)
- ▶ **One of the arguments against London's Green Belt is that the green belt hasn't prevented the city from growing. Why?** (In London's Green Belt it is difficult to get a permit for any construction on anything. And increases the inequality between people living in village areas and in the city)
