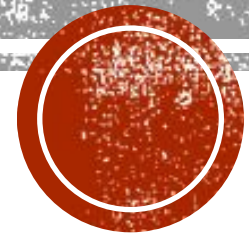

Spelling of 3rd person singular for verbs ending in:

ss, sh, ch, x, o + es	consonant + y → ies	vowel + y + s
