

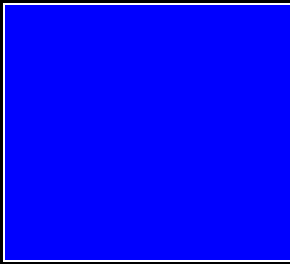
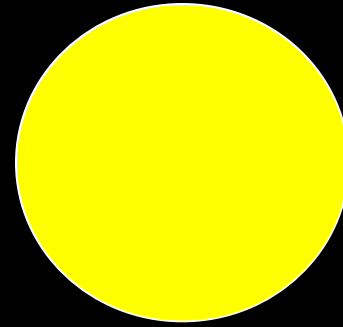

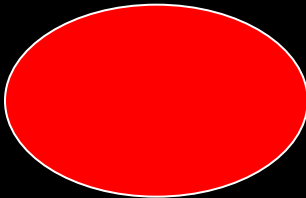
# SHAPE

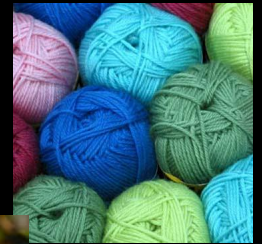

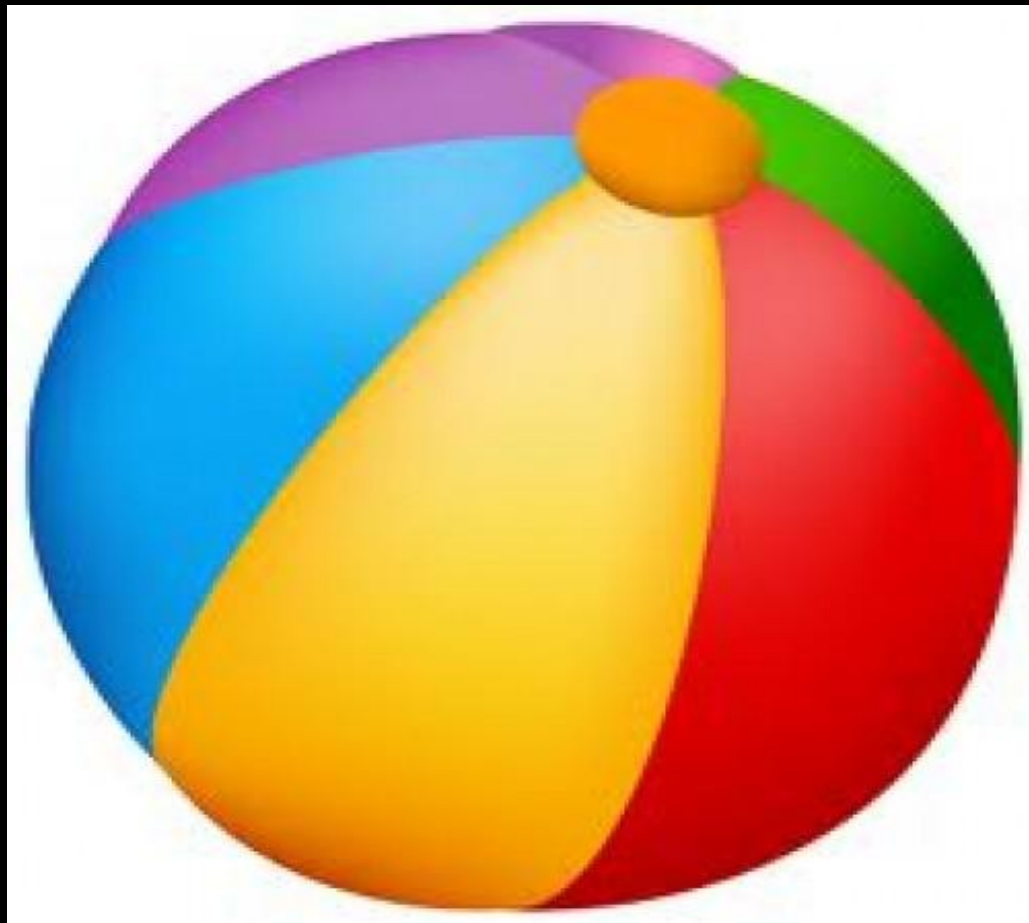

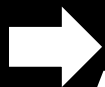
