

Past Simple (-ed)

Positive form	Negative Form	Question form
<b>I worked</b>	I <b>didn't</b> (=did not) work	<b>Did</b> I work?
<b>You worked</b>	You <b>didn't</b> work	<b>Did</b> you work?
<b>We worked</b>	We <b>didn't</b> work	<b>Did</b> we work?
<b>They worked</b>	They <b>didn't</b> work	<b>Did</b> they work?
<b>She worked</b>	She <b>didn't</b> work	<b>Did</b> she work?
<b>He worked</b>	He <b>didn't</b> work	<b>Did</b> he work?
<b>It worked</b>	It <b>didn't</b> work	<b>Did</b> it work?

## Past Indefinite (Simple)



Affirmative form

*Examples:* I **swam** in the river last summer.  
My friends **invited** me to the party yesterday.  
He **ate** strawberry last week.  
Her sister **walked** in the park three days ago.

## Past Indefinite (Simple)



Negative form



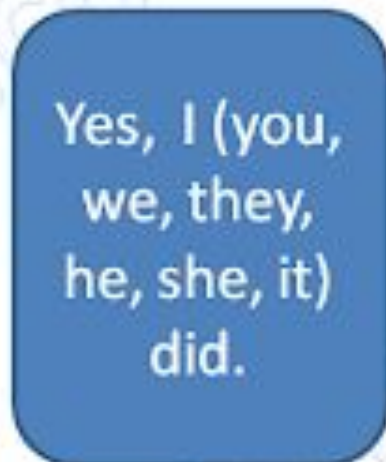
Examples: : I **didn't** swim in the river last summer.  
My friends **didn't** invite me to the party yesterday.  
He **didn't** eat strawberry last week.  
Her sister **didn't** walk in the park three days ago.



## Past Indefinite (Simple)



### Interrogative form



- Examples:* :
- **Did** you swim in the river last summer? – Yes, I did.
  - **Did** your friends invite you to the party yesterday? – Yes, they did.
  - **Did** he eat strawberry last week? – No, he didn't.
  - **Did** her sister walk in the park three days ago? – No, she didn't.

## **TIME MARKERS for the SIMPLE PAST**

- yesterday
- the day before yesterday
- last (*last week, last month, last year, etc.*)
- ago (*two days ago, three weeks ago, etc.*)
