



Past Indefinite (Simple)




My friends invited me to the party yesterday. He ate strawberry last week. Her sister walked in the park three days ago.

Past Indefinite (Simple)



Examples: : I didn't swim in the river last summer. My friends didn't invite me to the party yesterday. He didn't eat strawberry last week. Her sister didn't walk in the park three days ago.

Past Indefinite (Simple)



Examples: : - Did you swim in the river last summer? - Yes, I did. Did your friends invite you to the party yesterday? - Yes, they did. Did he eat strawberry last week? – No, he didn't. Did her sister walk in the park three days ago? – No, she didn't.
