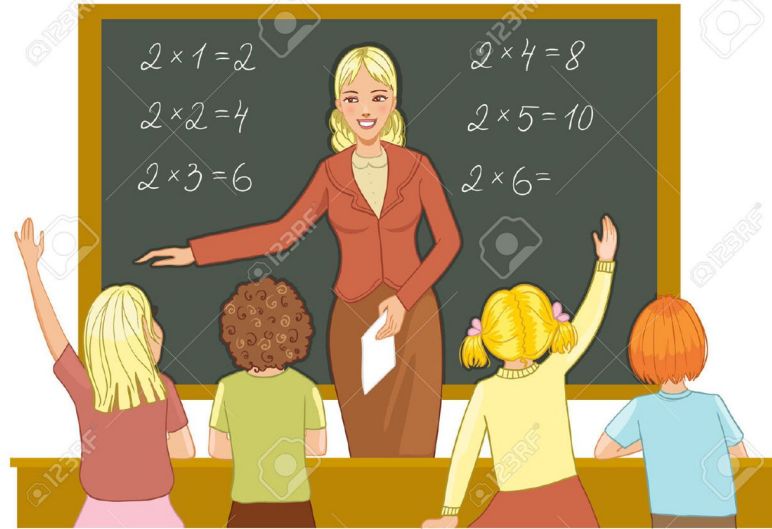

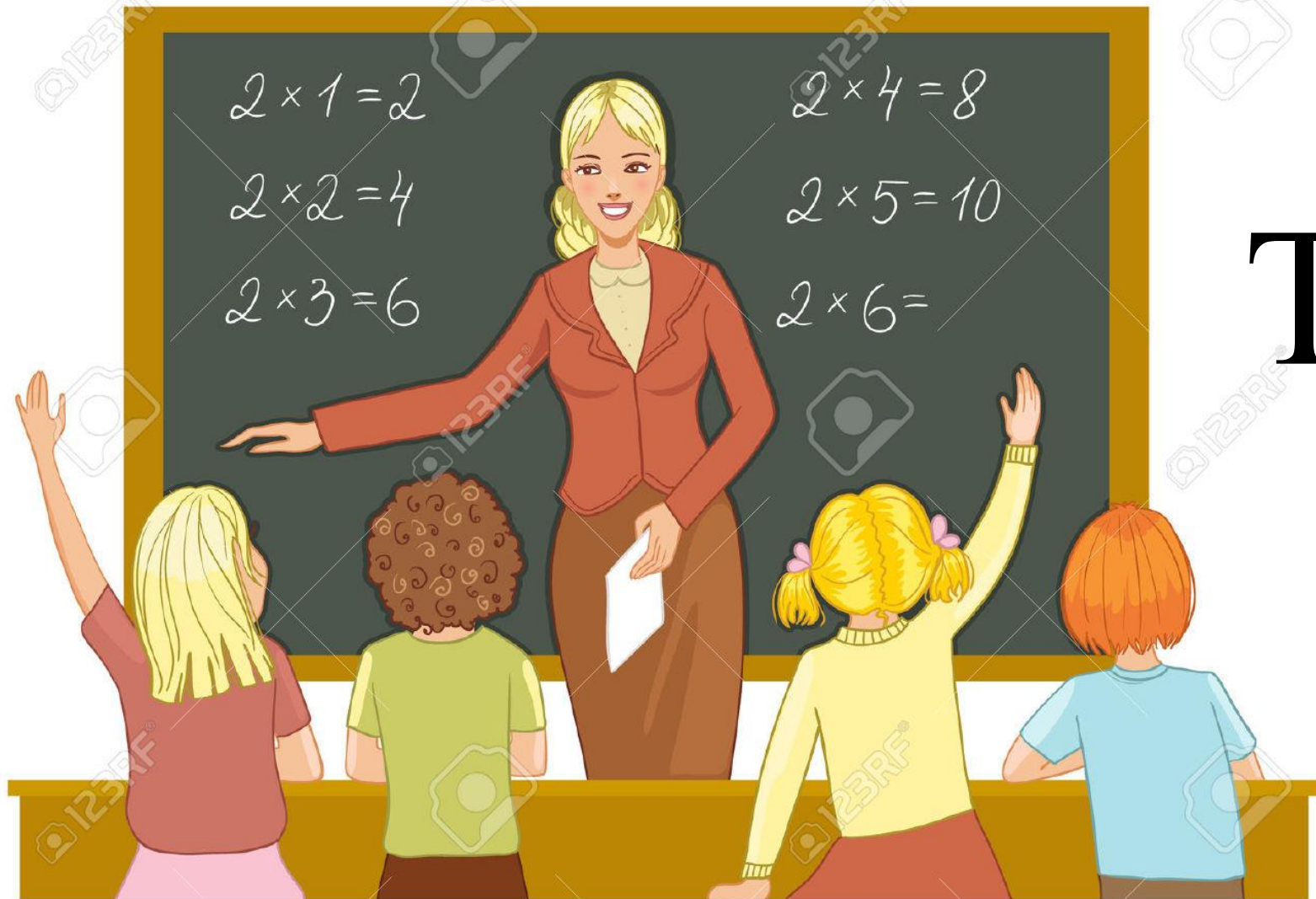

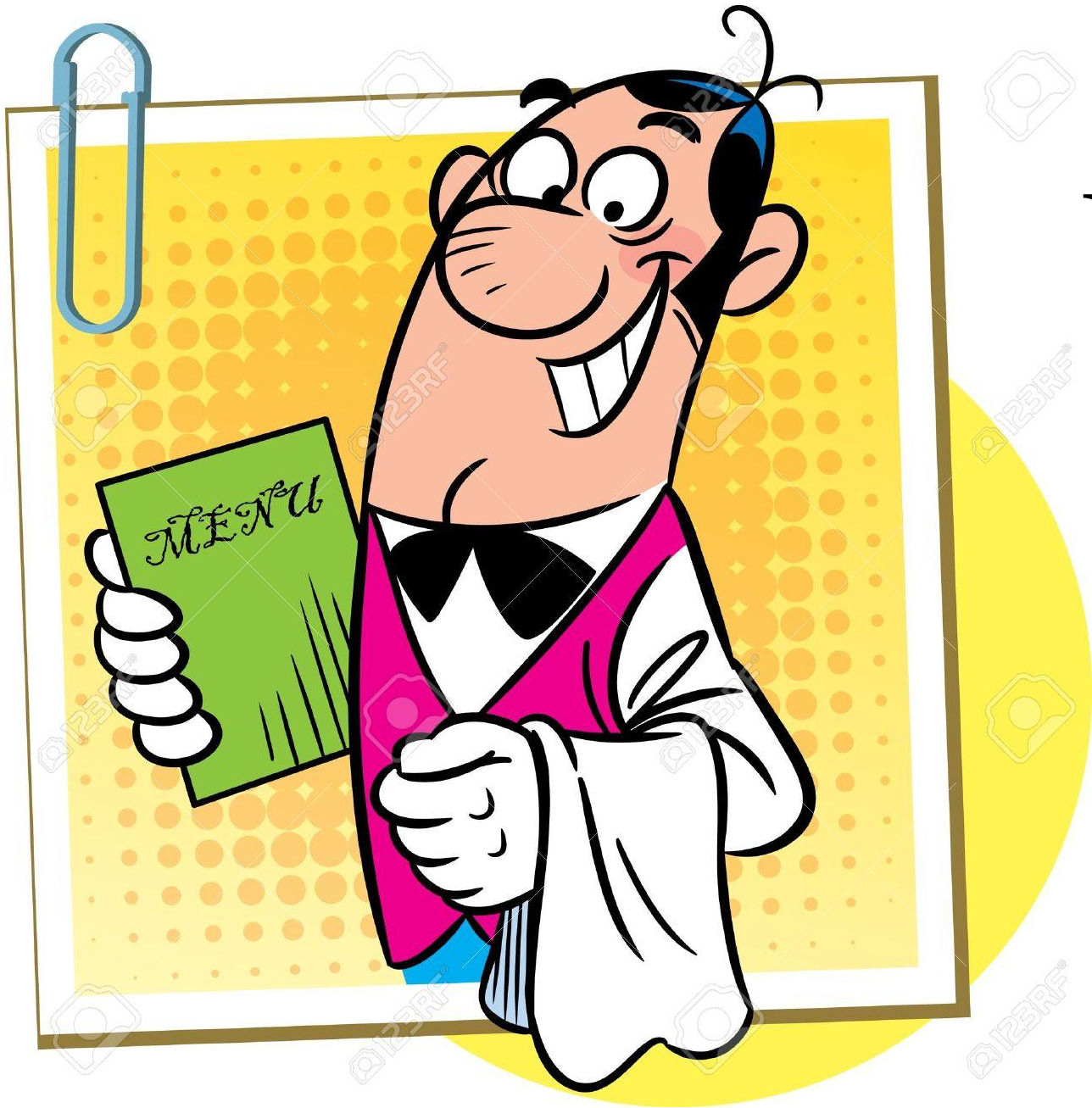

Formation

Affirmative

I	am /'m	
He / she / it	is / 's	doing (reading)
You / we / they	are / 're	

VERB + ING

Walk – walking

Dancee – dancing

Swim – swimmming

[ŋ]

Negative

I am not / 'm not

He / she / it is not / isn't

You / we / they are not / aren't

doing (reading)

Interrogative

Am		I		
Is		he / she / it		doing (reading) ?
Are		you / we / they		

Short answers

Yes, I am.	No, I am not.
Yes, he/she/it is.	No, he/she/it isn't.
Yes, you/we/they are.	No, you/we/they aren't.
