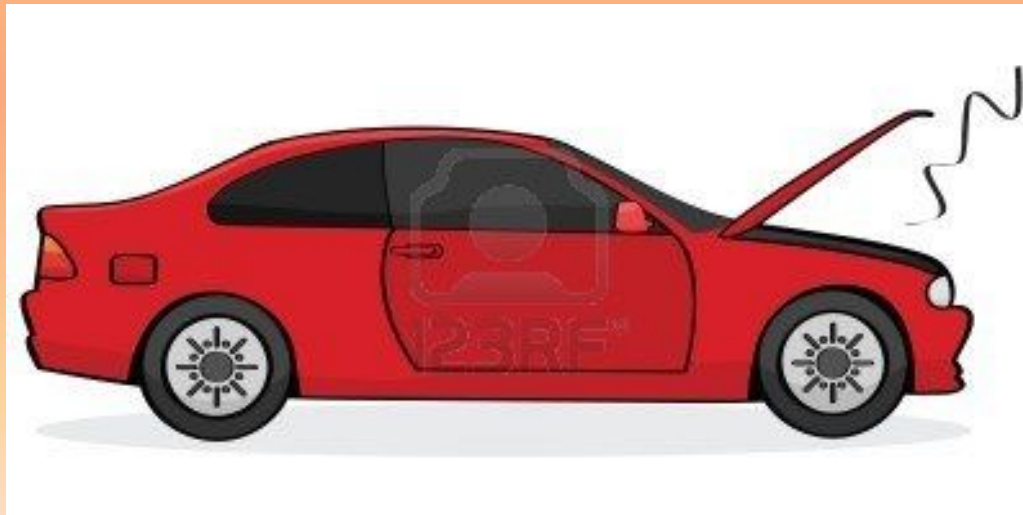


Have something done

Causative

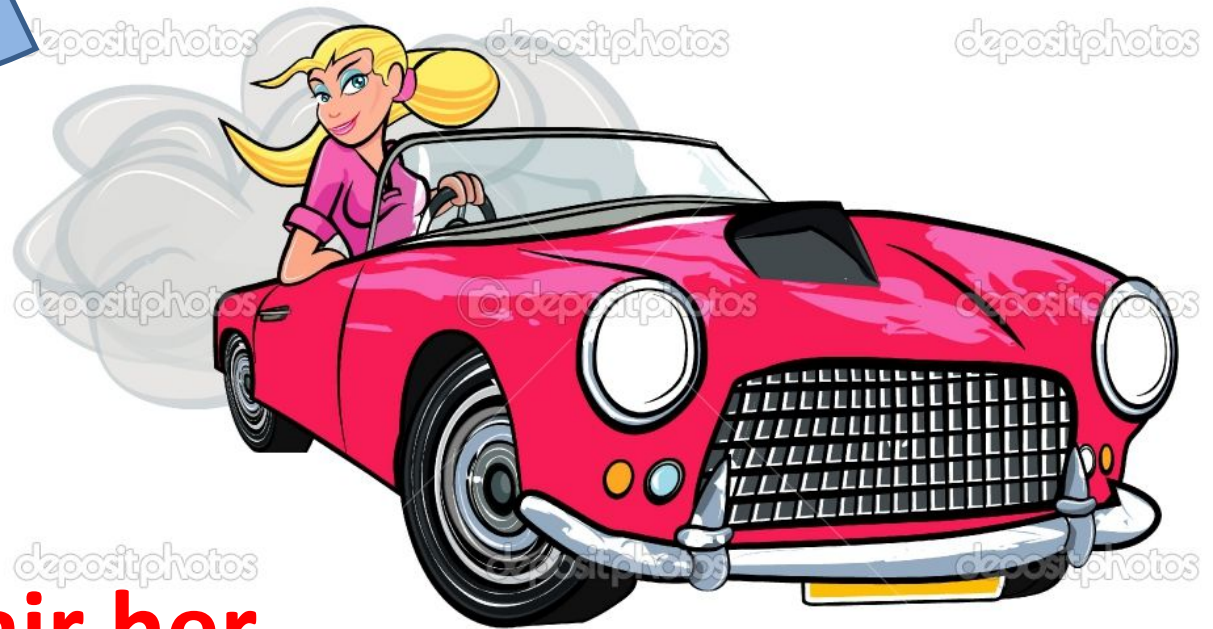
My car was

**Who repaired her
car?**

- We don't know.



**Did she repair her
car herself?**

- No, she didn't.

A mechanic
repaired
my car.



- Use **have/get + object + past participle** to talk about things other people do for you.
- You can use **have/get something done** in variety of tenses:

– *I have my car repaired.*

– *I had my car repaired.*

– *I will my car repaired.*

– *I'd have my car repaired if I had enough money.*

I get all my clothes made by a designer.

(have/bring)



I **get** my homework **done** by
my older brother .
(get/do)

(have/inject)
