---

- это настоящее простое время
- используется, когда действие повторяется регулярно, постоянно, всегда, каждый день/каждую неделю/каждый месяц, часто, обычно
- в 3 лице единственного числа к глаголу добавляется окончание **-s или -es**
- **Вспомогательные глаголы - do/ does**

# Present Simple

## краткие ответы



Лицо	Единственное число	Множественное число
1	Yes, I do/No, I don't.	Yes, we do/No, we don't.
2	Yes, you do/No, you don't.	Yes, you do/No, you don't.
3	Yes, he does/No, he doesn't.	Yes, they do/No, they don't.
	Yes, she does/No, she doesn't.	
	Yes, it does/No, it doesn't.

# Present Simple

## отрицательные предложения



Лицо	Единственное число	Множественное число
1	I <b>don't</b> go to college	We <b>don't</b> go to college
2	You <b>don't</b> go to college	You <b>don't</b> go to college
3	He <b>doesn't</b> go to college She <b>doesn't</b> go to college It <b>doesn't</b> go to college	They <b>don't</b> go to college



We use *always, usually, sometimes, hardly ever, never* + **present simple** to talk about how often we do things. These words go **before** the verb.

---

○ I *always* play outside
