



Australia

- Example: He got aggro with me. This is also used as a noun "she was really giving me the aggro."




Ambo

- Example: Is it beer o'clock yet?




Cheerio

- Another slang term for cigarette is **fag.**




Cark It

Doco


- **Doco** means watching a documentary.

- I gave him the **flick**. (This is used when you are trying to get rid of someone. This happens in an abrupt manner.






