

Peter the Great St. Petersburg Polytechnic University (SPbPU,, full name — Federal State Autonomous Educational Institution of Higher Education "Peter the Great St. Petersburg Polytechnic University"[2], unofficial name — Polytech) is a higher educational institution in St. Petersburg. It was founded in 1899. It has the status of a national research university (NRU)[3]. In 2021, Higher Education (THE) ranks first among Russian technical universities in the Times international ranking



The Pyotr Ilyich Tchaikov sky Moscow State Conservatory

The Pyotr Ilyich Tchaikovsky Moscow State Conservatory[2] is a higher musical educational institution in Moscow, one of the leading music universities in Russia and the world. The idea of establishing a conservatory in Moscow was first expressed in 1819 by Friedrich Scholz, the conductor of the Bolshoi Theater, but the idea did not find support. 11 years later, in 1830, he managed to get permission to open "free teaching of general bass and composition" at his home.



Mari State University

Mari State University (lugovomar. Mari Kugyzhanysh University) is a higher educational institution located in the city of Yoshkar-Ola of the Republic of Mari El. One of the regional reference universities. MarGU has a certificate of state accreditation dated December 30, 2020[2] and a license for educational activities dated January 29, 2016, issued by the Federal Service for Supervision of Education and Science[3]. On the recommendation of the Ministry of Education and Science of the Republic of Mari El, Mari State University was included in the National Register of "Leading Scientific Organizations of Russia" (2016)




Moskow Institute of Electronic Technology
