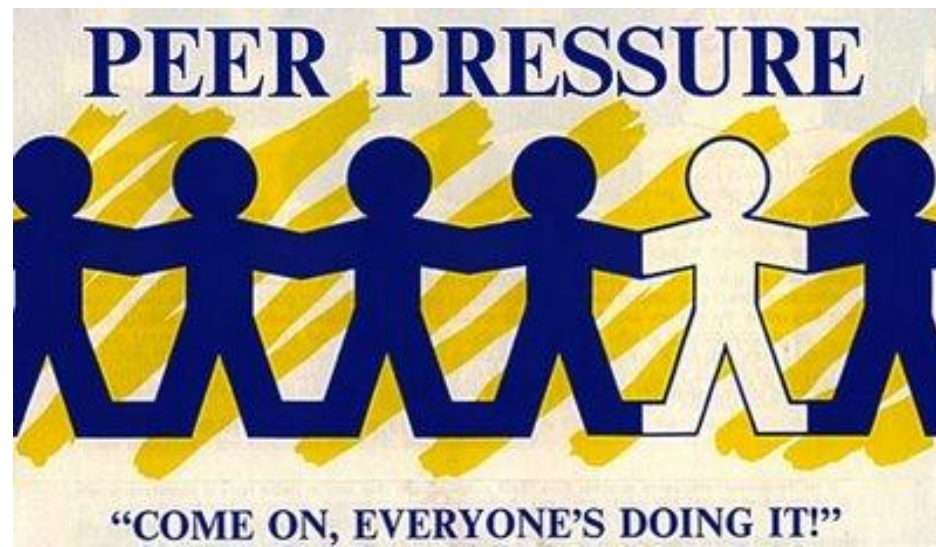




PEER - a person of the same age, status, or ability as another specified person.

Jane shouldn't let her friends influence her decisions.

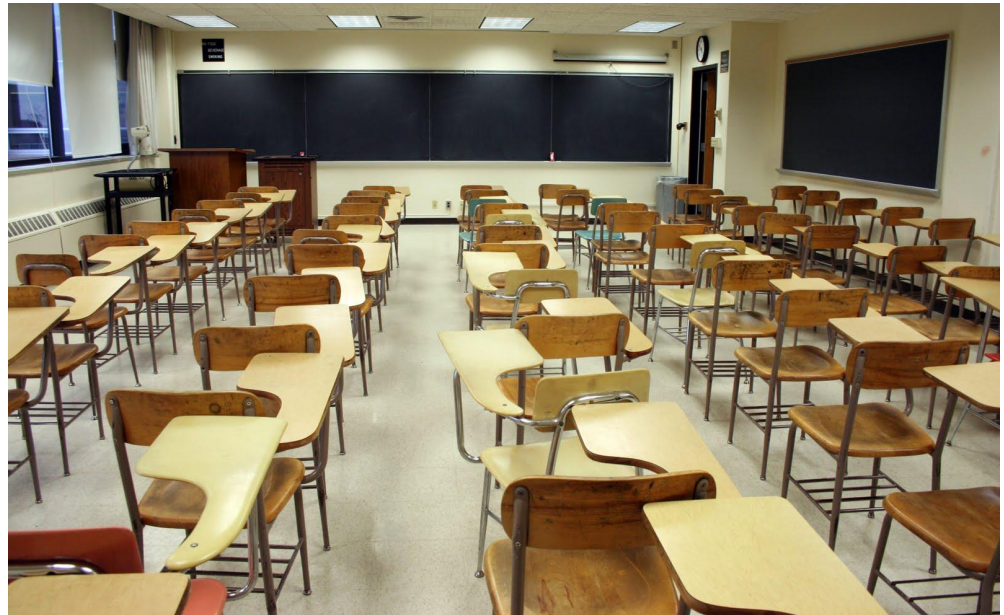
Some people follow the habits of others easily.
