
IF YOU CAN KEEP YOUR HEAD WHEN ALL ABOUT YOU

IF YOU CAN WAIT AND NOT BE TIRED BY WAITING,
OR BEING LIED ABOUT, DON'T DEAL IN LIES,
OR BEING HATED, DON'T GIVE WAY TO HATING,
AND YET DON'T LOOK TOO GOOD, NOR TALK TOO WISE:

IF YOU CAN DREAM—AND NOT MAKE DREAMS YOUR MASTER;
IF YOU CAN THINK—AND NOT MAKE THOUGHTS YOUR AIM;
IF YOU CAN MEET WITH TRIUMPH AND DISASTER
AND TREAT THOSE TWO IMPOSTORS JUST THE SAME;
IF YOU CAN BEAR TO HEAR THE TRUTH YOU'VE SPOKEN
TWISTED BY KNAVES TO MAKE A TRAP FOR FOOLS,
OR WATCH THE THINGS YOU GAVE YOUR LIFE TO, BROKEN,
AND STOOP AND BUILD 'EM UP WITH WORN-OUT TOOLS:

IF YOU CAN MAKE ONE HEAP OF ALL YOUR WINNINGS
AND RISK IT ON ONE TURN OF PITCH-AND-TOSS,
AND LOSE, AND START AGAIN AT YOUR BEGINNINGS
AND NEVER BREATHE A WORD ABOUT YOUR LOSS;
IF YOU CAN FORCE YOUR HEART AND NERVE AND SINEW
TO SERVE YOUR TURN LONG AFTER THEY ARE GONE,
AND SO HOLD ON WHEN THERE IS NOTHING IN YOU
EXCEPT THE WILL WHICH SAYS TO THEM: 'HOLD ON!'

IF YOU CAN TALK WITH CROWDS AND KEEP YOUR VIRTUE,
OR WALK WITH KINGS—NOR LOSE THE COMMON TOUCH,
IF NEITHER FOES NOR LOVING FRIENDS CAN HURT YOU,




Редьярд Киплинг Из стихотворения «Если»

CONDITION



RESULT

ZERO

If you stand in the rain, you get wet.
If you heat ice, it melts.

PRESENT SIMPLE



PRESENT SIMPLE

USES: Facts which are generally true or scientific facts The condition always has the same result

FIRST

If it rains, If you study, we will cancel the trip. you will pass the exam.

PRESENT SIMPLE



WILL / WON'T + VERB

USES: A possible situation in the future

Predicting a likely result in the future (if the condition happens)

SECOND

If I won the lottery, I would travel a lot. If they sold their house, they would be rich.

PAST SIMPLE



WOULD + VERB

USES: Hypothetical or unlikely situations
Unreal or improbable situation now or in the future

THIRD

If you had studied, If I hadn't been sick, you would have passed the exam.

I would have gone to your party.


PAST PERFECT



WOULD HAVE + PAST PARTICIPLE

USES: The person is imagining a different past Imaginary situation that did not happen
