Geography of Belgium

- Belgium is a small country in the European continent. It's located in the Southwest of France, in the North of the Netherlands and the east of Germany and the Luxembourg.
- Belgium has only one coast so one sea: the North Sea. The surface of the country is 30 528 km2 and has a population of over 11 million.

History

• In 1944, Belgium united with the Luxembourg and The Netherlands to form the Benelux and to be more powerful. The slogan of our country is: "unity is strength". Belgium is also one of the 6 countries who created the European Union.


 We also have Belgian very known painters like Rubens or René Magritte.
