

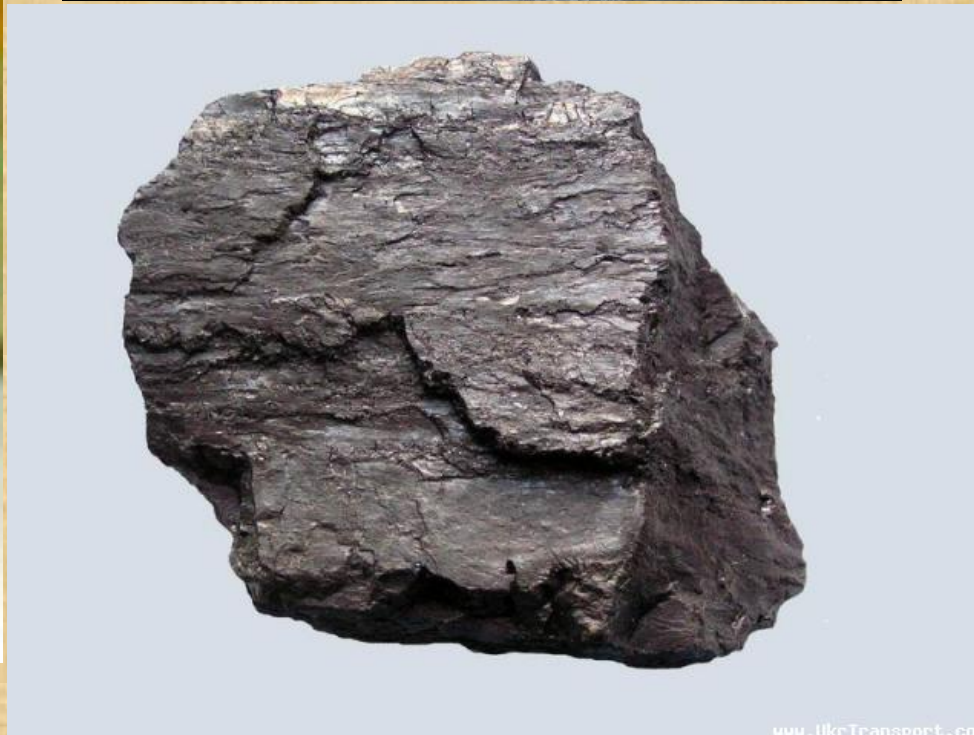
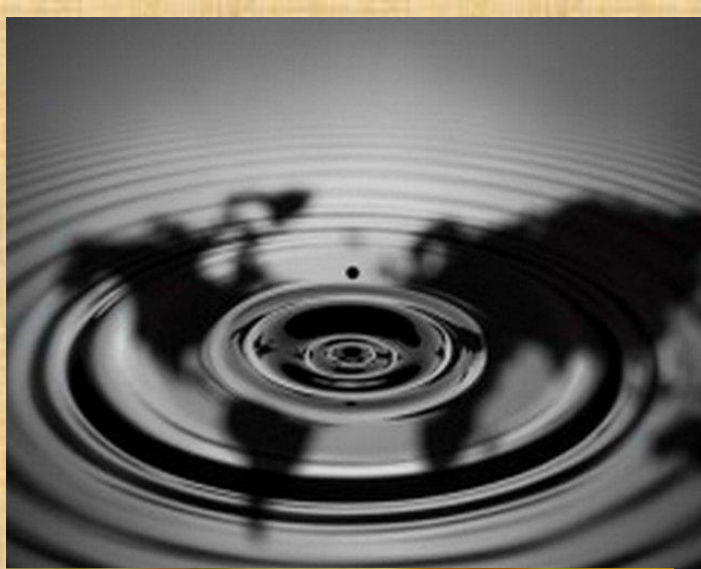
Conflict in the Ukraine.

Causes of the conflict.

- The Euromaidan protests started in November 2013 when radical groups used weapons. On the eve of these actions then president Viktor Yanukovych refused to sign an association agreement with the European Union, describing it as disadvantageous to Ukraine.
