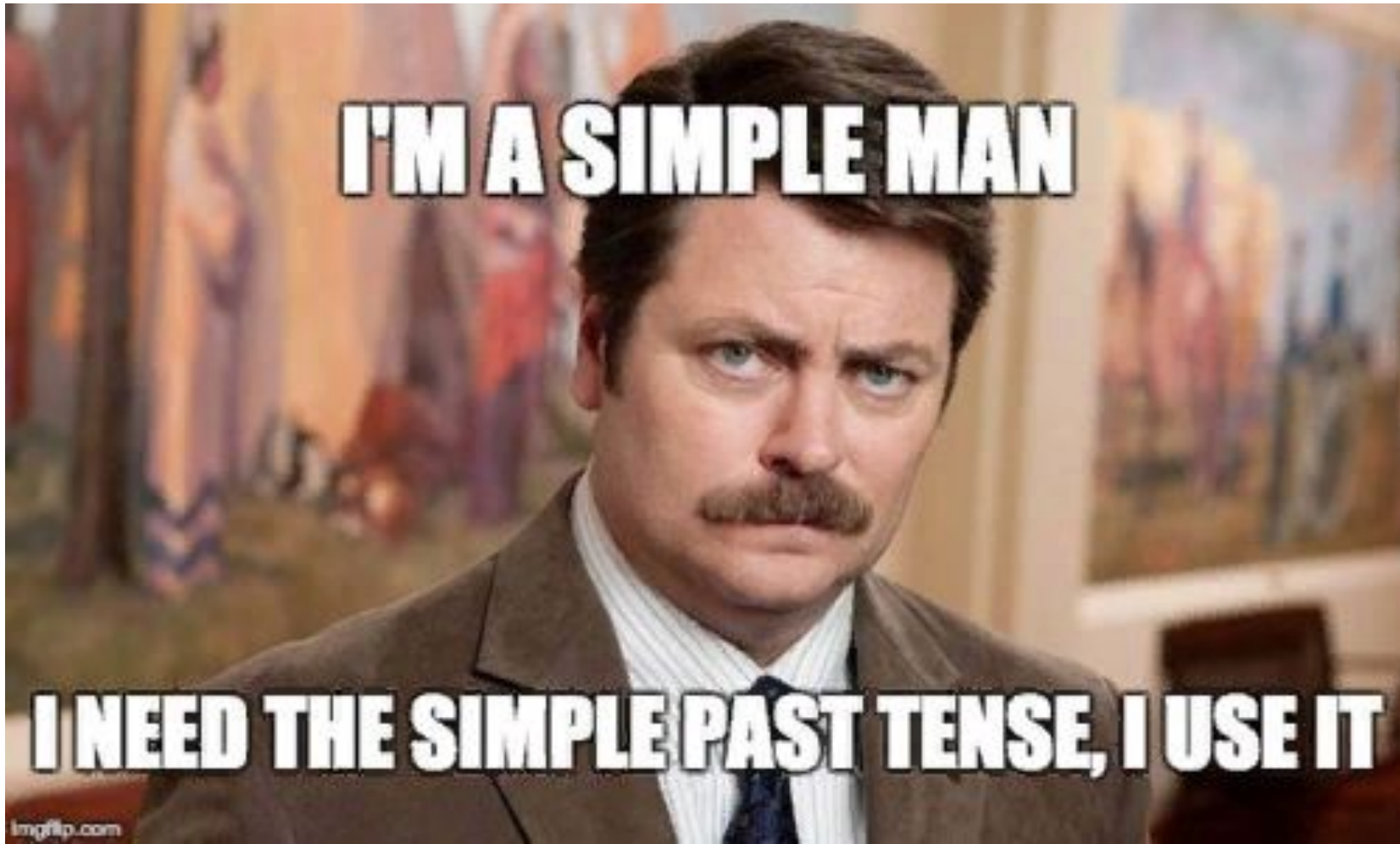

1. **Описания действий, событий, фактов в прошлом, которые не связаны с настоящим моментом (finished actions).**

- *I went to the cinema yesterday.*
- *We met Mary last year.*
- *Leonardo painted the Mona Lisa.*
- *He lived in Canada.*

2. **Последовательность действий при описании событий в прошлом (for stories or lists of events).**

- *I came home, opened the door and switched on the TV-set.*
- *He went to a restaurant. He sat down and ordered a coffee.*

Обстоятельства времени: *ago, last week (month, year), yesterday, the day before yesterday, in those times.*

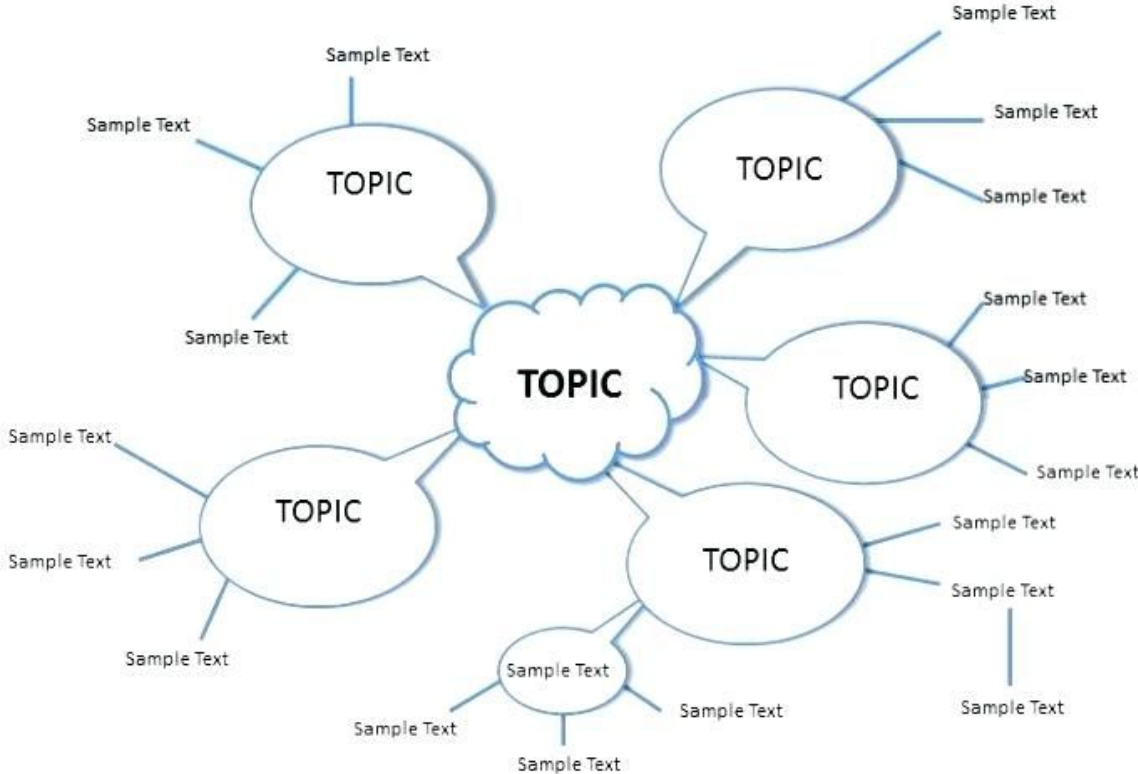

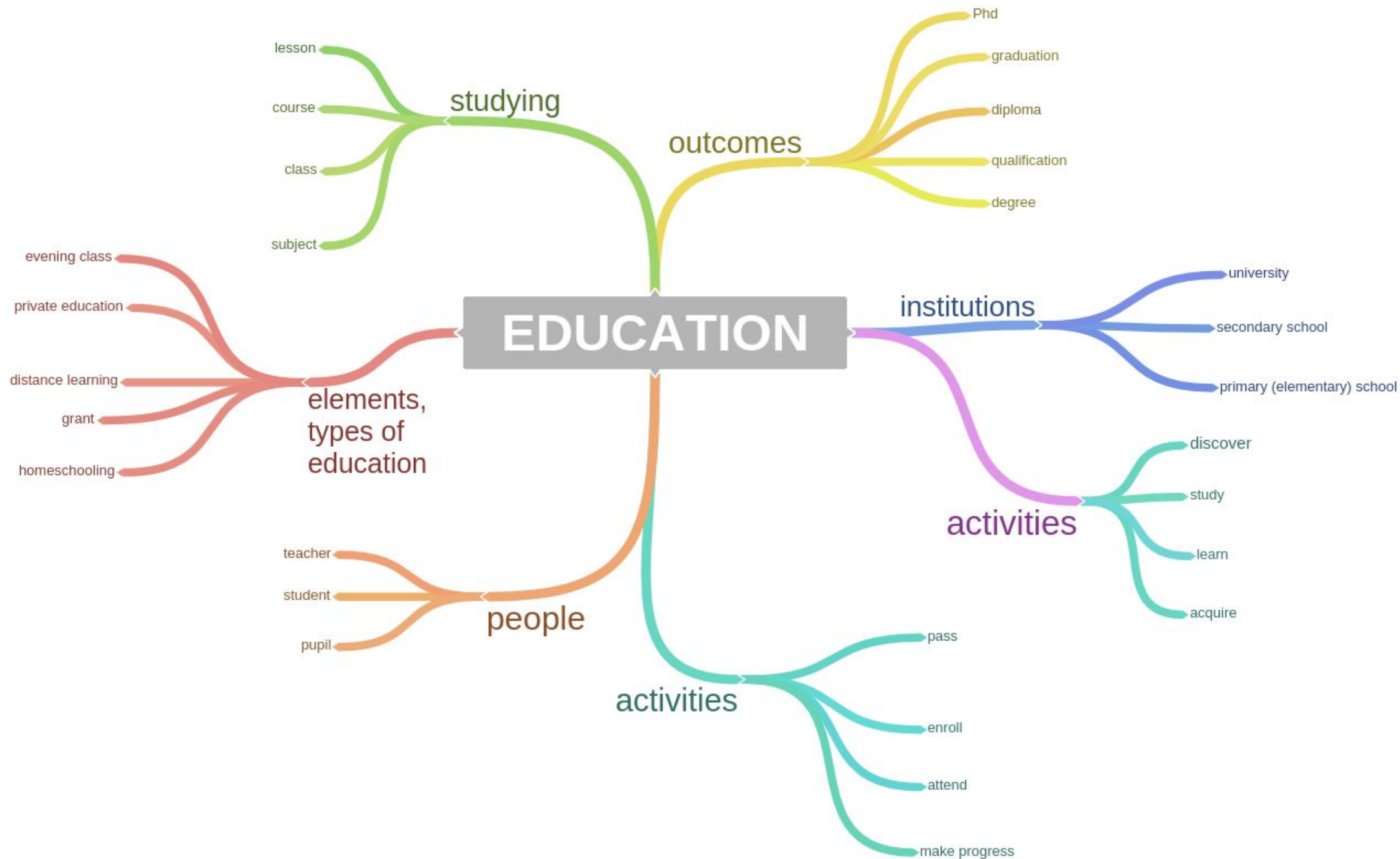
