We'll go there in all weathers.



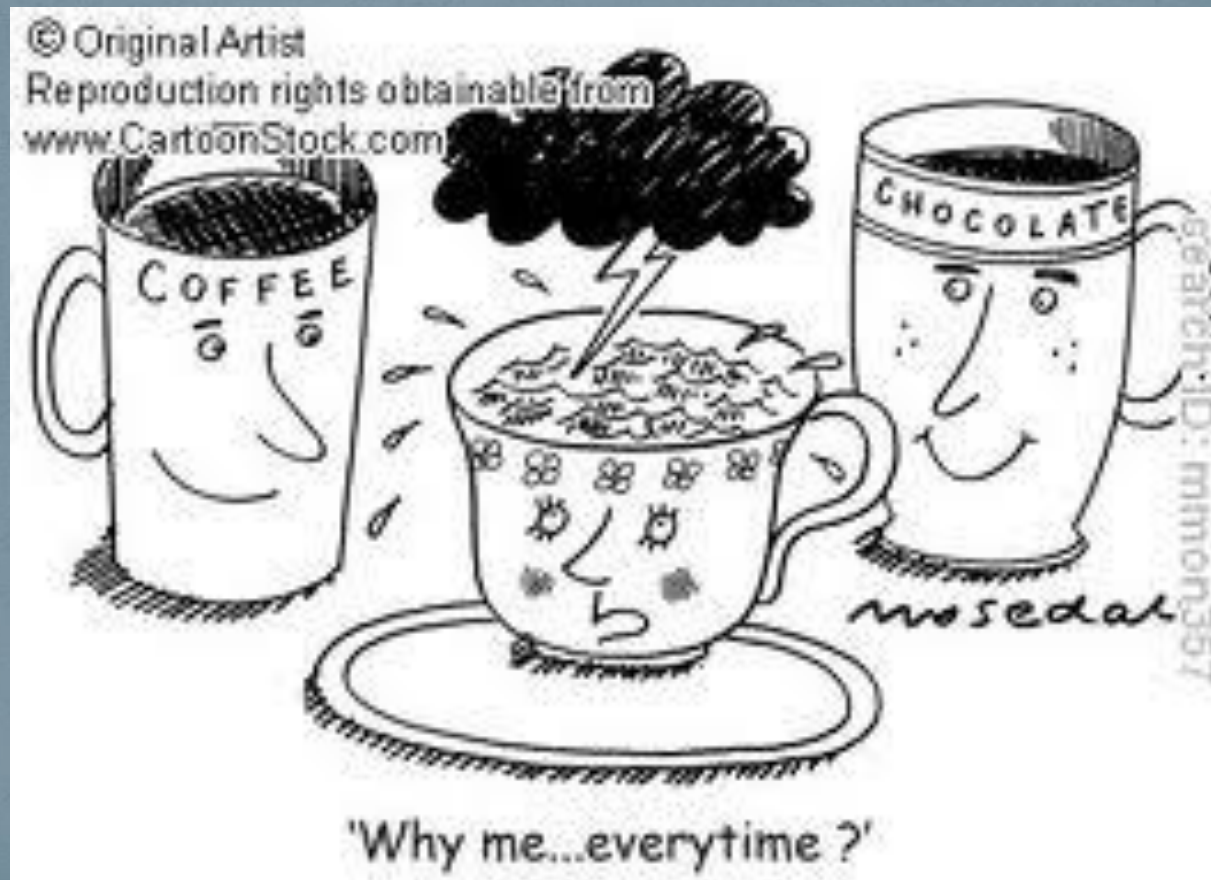
