


Present Simple

Present Simple +

- I live
- You live
- He lives
- She lives
- It lives

- We live
- You live
- They live

Present Simple Spelling Rules

Most verbs takes -s in the third person singular. (He/ She/ it)





Negative

(Отрицательные предложения)

- o I don't play
- o You don't play
- o We don't play
- o They don't play

- He <u>doesn't</u>play
- o She <u>doesn't</u> play
- o It <u>doesn't</u> play

do not = don't

does not = doesn't

THE PRESENT SIMPLE

• Вопросительная форма

<u>Do</u> <u>work</u> every day?

Does he / she / it work every day?

Do we / you / they work every day?



Questions

Short answers

Do I/we/you/they work?

Yes, I/we/they do. No, I/we/they don't.

Does he/she/it work?

Yes, he/she/it does. No, he/she/it doesn't.



They don't walk


INTERROGATIVE

Do you walk?
Does she walk?
Does he walk?
Does it walk?
Do we walk?
Do you walk?
Do they walk?

Глаголы**-**помощники Для отрицаний и вопросов

Do	I, you, we, they
Does	He, she, it

Правило окончаний глаголов в утверждениях!





Examples!

- + I like sweets. She likes sweets.
- I don't like sweets. She doesn't like sweets.
- Oo you like sweets? Yes, I do /No, I don't.
 Does she like sweets? Yes, she does/ No, she doesn't.
