Giving animals or objects human characteristics

The stars danced in the night.

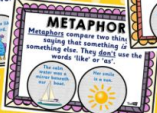
## Onomatopoeia

Imitate a sound

"Beep" "beep"

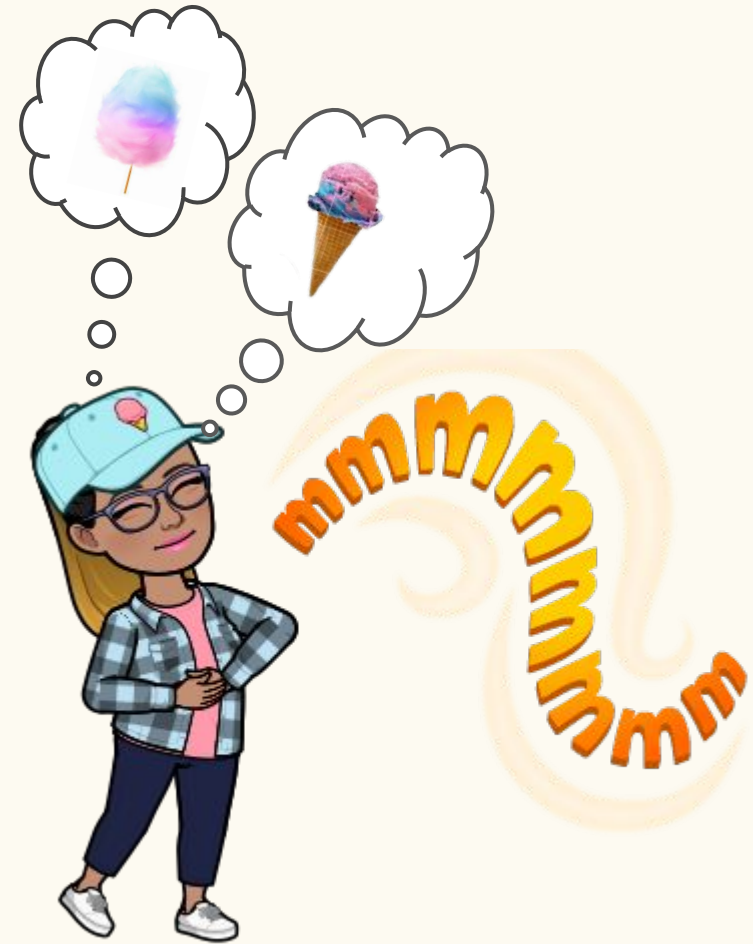

Personification, the human characteristic described in the sentence is winking.







**Cheese burgers are gold.**

**Metaphor, cheeseburger - gold are being compared.**



**That wonderful smell of meat  
“sizzling” in the grill.**

**Onomatopoeia, makes a sizzling

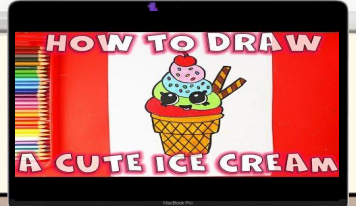
