in your hair.




And when you walk around, you'll see

This tea is mine for free!





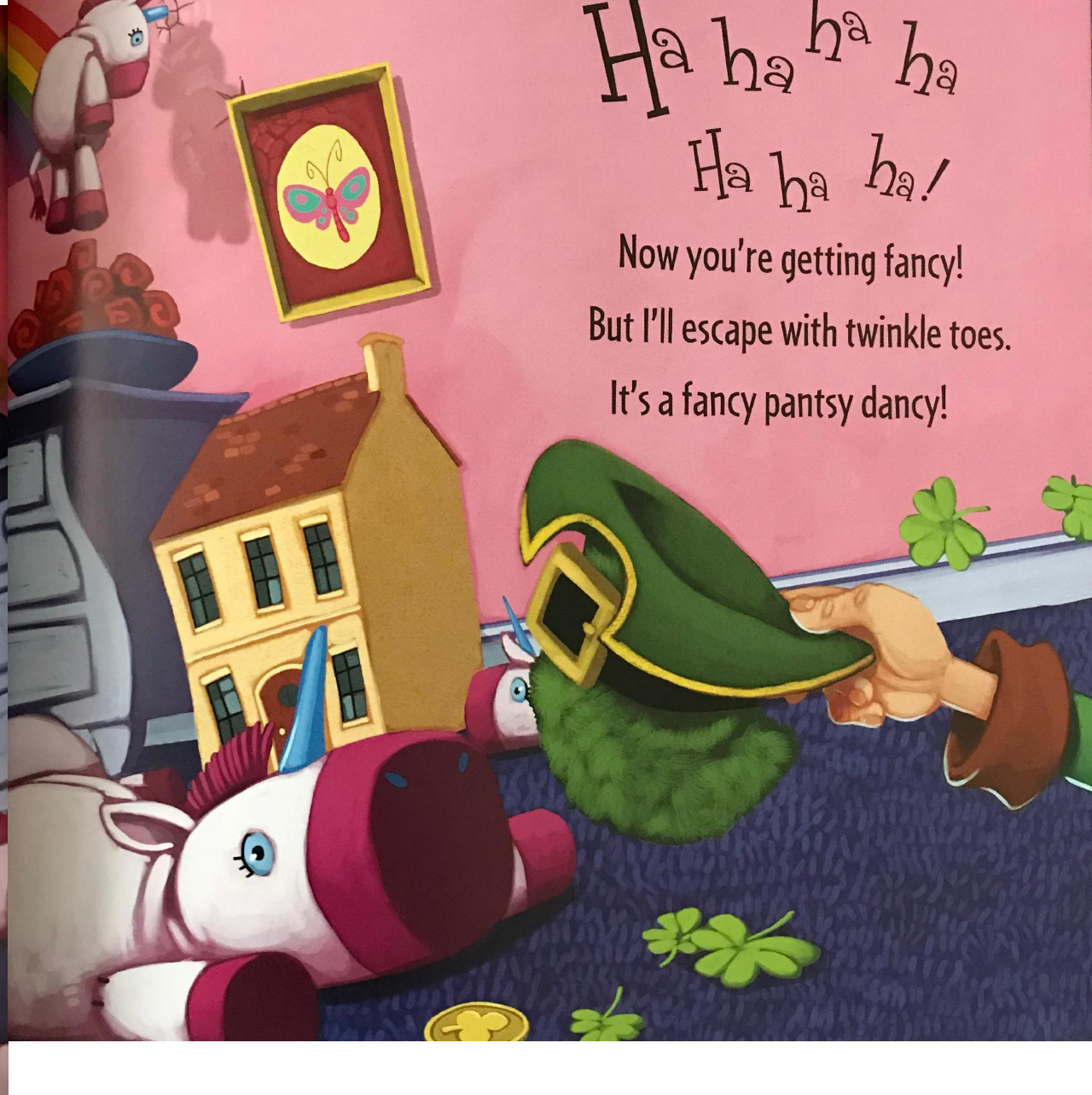
I know you want my pot of gold.
