4 In Britain, there is no residence permit, but without a Bank account and a card, there is almost nothing you can do, much less live legally. The place of residence is determined by invoices that are paid through a Bank account. All the bills are proof that you have lived here and may be needed for various bureaucratic needs. Therefore, a resident of Britain at home keeps a lot of waste paper from paper utility bills, salary payslips.



5 You can only watch TV at home by paying a tax of about 10 pounds a month. Special services can come and check whether you have a TV license. The tax goes into the pocket of the Royal air force of great Britain. Due to it, there is much less advertising on television than in Russia, for example.
