RESPECT THE AUDIENCE



IV. ASK QUESTIONS

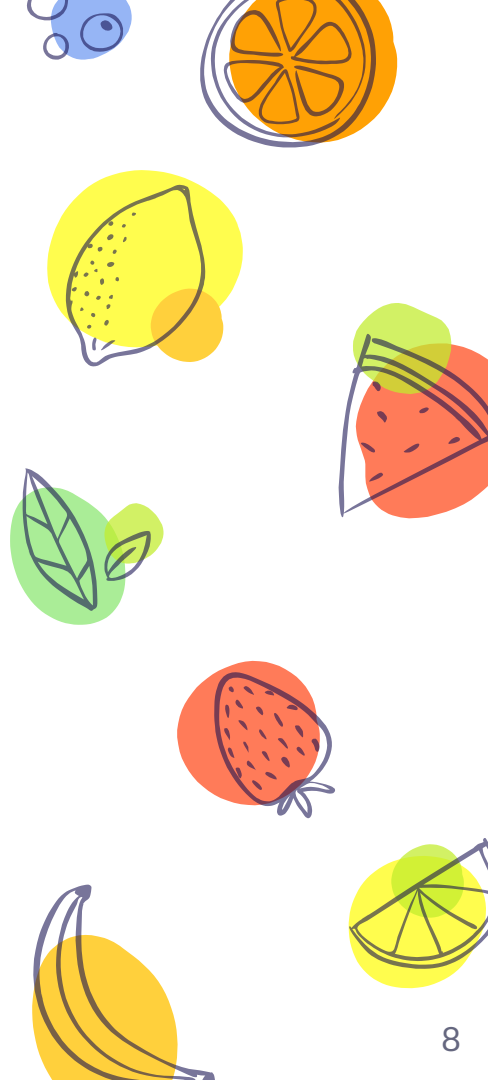
DON'TS
