I WAS SITTING IN a taxi, wondering if I had overdressed for the evening, when I looked out the window and saw a woman rooting through a Dumpster.



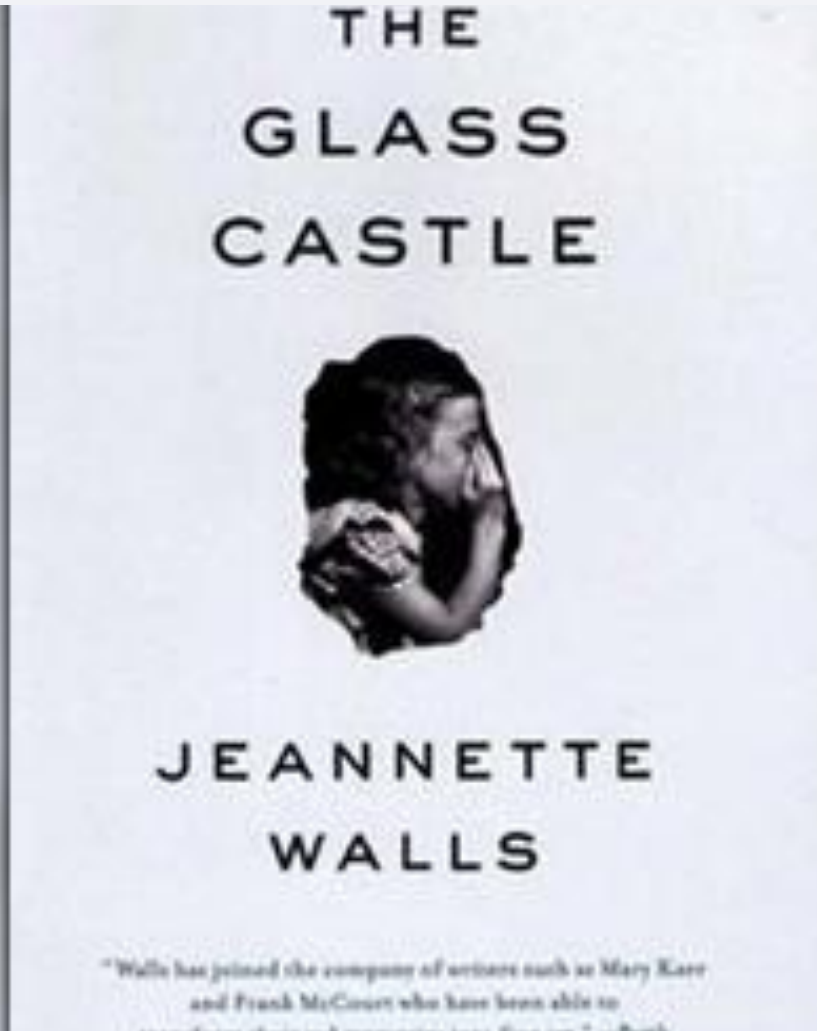


# About the writer
