(singular – ед. ч. существительного)
- We use **some** in affirmative plural.
(plural – мн. ч. существительного)
- We use **any** in the negative and

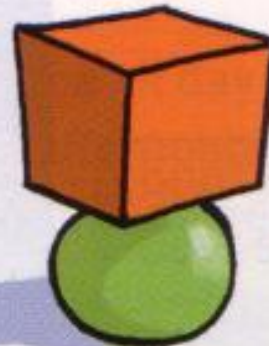

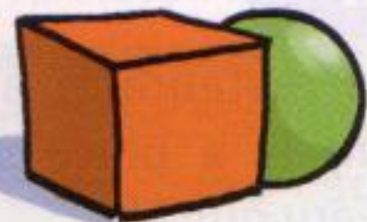

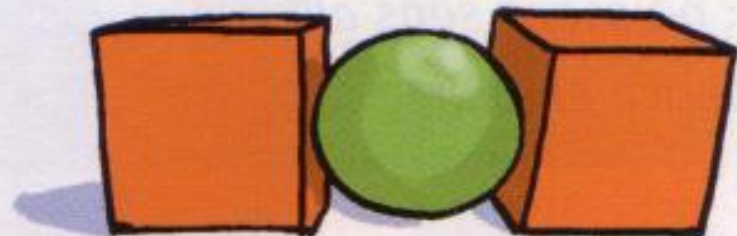
