

Georgy Zhukov was born in the village Strelkovka Maloyaroslavetsky County Kaluga province in a peasant family Artemyevitch Konstantin Zhukov (1844-1921).

After graduating with a certificate of merit of three classes of a parochial school in the neighboring village Velichkovo, the summer of 1908, her mother arranged for her brother Michael Pilihinu - furrier furrier and owner of a small shop in Moscow.

Late in the evening of July, 1908, accompanied by his uncle Sergei on suburban Moscow train left for Moscow. The next day he began his thorny, fifteen hours a day training. In the 13 years arrives independently at the evening general education courses on Tverskaya Street, which allowed the formation volume in urban schools. In 1911, being engaged in the evenings, passed exams for the full course of urban schools and receives a certificate.
