# BIOGRAPHY:

- HE WAS BORN ON OCTOBER 25, 1925 IN THE VILLAGE BULAK OF KOBDA DISTRICT OF AKTOBE REGION IN THE FAMILY OF NURMUKHAMMED SARKULOV AND MARZHAN MOLDAGULOV. AS A CHILD, HE LOST HIS MOTHER (1933), THEN LIVED IN ALMATY WITH HIS BROTHER, AND SINCE 1935 HE WAS BROUGHT UP IN AN ORPHANAGE NO. 46 ON GURDIN STREET, LENINGRAD, KRASNOGVARDEYSKY DISTRICT. HE STUDIED AT THE 9TH SECONDARY SCHOOL OF ST. PETERSBURG. FOR EXCELLENT ACADEMIC AND EXEMPLARY DISCIPLINE ALIA GOES TO THE ALL-UNION CAMP OF PIONEERS IN THE CRIMEA-ARTEK. ALONG WITH SUCH HEROES AS RUBEN IBARRURI, TIMUR FRUNZE, PHOTOS OF ALIYA MOLDAGULOVA WERE ALSO PRESENTED IN THE ARTIFACT ON THE BOARD OF THE BATYRS. AFTER THE BEGINNING OF THE WAR, TOGETHER WITH THE ORPHANAGE, HE WAS EVACUATED TO THE VILLAGE OF VYATSKOYE, YAROSLAVL REGION. AFTER THE END OF THE 7 CLASS VYATKA SECONDARY SCHOOLS ENTERED RYBINSK AVIATION COLLEGE, BUT SOON (1942) SENDS IN LLC (WORKER-PEASANT RED ARMY) STATEMENT ABOUT DIRECTION ON FRONT.
- IN 1943 HE GRADUATED FROM THE CENTRAL WOMEN'S SCHOOL FOR TRAINING SNIPERS. SINCE 1943, THE 54TH SPECIAL SHOOTER

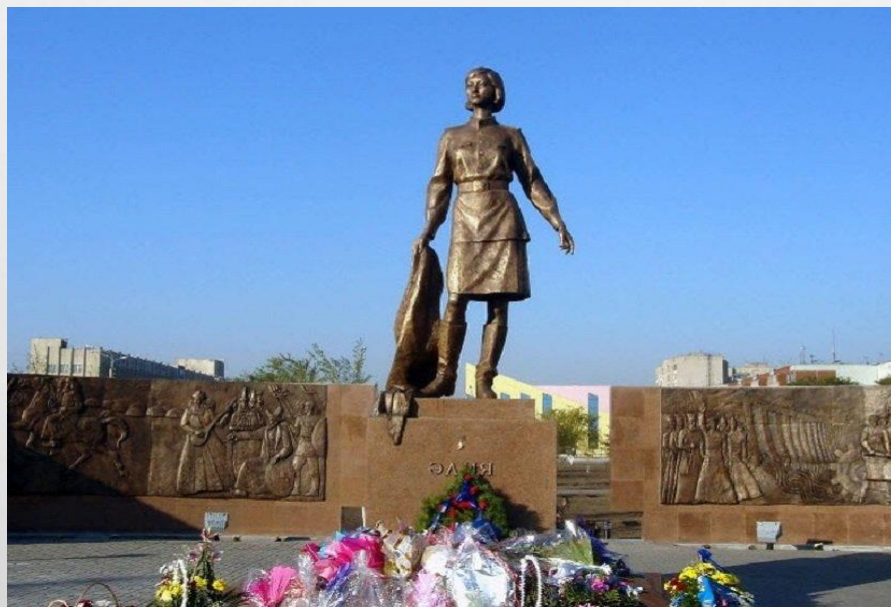

- IN THE MEMORY OF THE PEOPLE. ALIA'S LIFE IS SHORT AND FULL OF HEROISM. HIS IMAGE WILL FOREVER REMAIN IN THE MEMORY OF THE PEOPLE. THE NAME OF ALIYAH AND NOW WE HAVE MONUMENTS, STREETS, SCHOOLS, MUSEUMS, POETS DEDICATE POEMS, WROTE SONGS OF COMPOSERS, BRUSH MASTERS MADE THE IMAGE OF ALIYAH.

# FAMILY

IN 1933, THE MOLDAGULOV FAMILY MOVED FROM SHALKAR TO ZHAMBYL, THEN TO THE SMALL STATION OF AULIEATA. MY UNCLE WORKED AS AN INSTRUCTOR OF THE POLITICAL DEPARTMENT OF THE THIRD OPERATIONAL DISTRICT OF THE TURKESTAN-SIBERIAN RAILWAY. THE HOUSES WERE NEAR THE RAILWAY STATION. HE STUDIED IN THE FIRST GRADE AT THE RAILWAY SCHOOL NEAR THE HOUSE. IN 1935, UNCLE AUBAKIR ENTERED THE MILITARY TRANSPORT ACADEMY, WITH HIS FAMILY MOVED TO MOSCOW, AND BEFORE THE WAR, TOGETHER WITH THE ACADEMY MOVED TO LENINGRAD. IN LENINGRAD, HE LIVED IN THE SMOLENSK REGION ON THE STREET SLUTSKY 2ND HOME. FOR FAMILY REASONS, UNCLE ALIYAN TRANSFERRED TO THE ORPHANAGE NO. 46 ON GURDIN STREET IN THE KRASNOGVARDEYSKY DISTRICT. STUDENTS OF THIS ORPHANAGE STUDIED AT SCHOOL NO. 9 ON BOLSHAYA OKHTA AVENUE, WHICH IS LOCATED NEARBY, NOW IT IS SCHOOL NO. 140. IN 1980, BY THE DECISION OF THE EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE OF THE LENINGRAD CITY COUNCIL, GURDIN STREET WAS NAMED AFTER ALIA MOLDAGULOVA.



# DEATH OF THE HEROINE

- January 14, 1944 was a heroic day for the Motherland, for the Motherland, for the Motherland, for heroism and heroism-the male daughter of the Kazakh people, the daughter of Leningrad Aliya Nurmukhammedovna Moldagulova. Her battalion friends swore an oath that for alia we could avenge the enemy. By decree of the Supreme Soviet of the Union of Soviet Socialist Republics, corporal alia Nurmukhammedovna Moldagulova was awarded the title of Hero of the Soviet Union for her courage on June 4, 1944.
