
high-rise flats

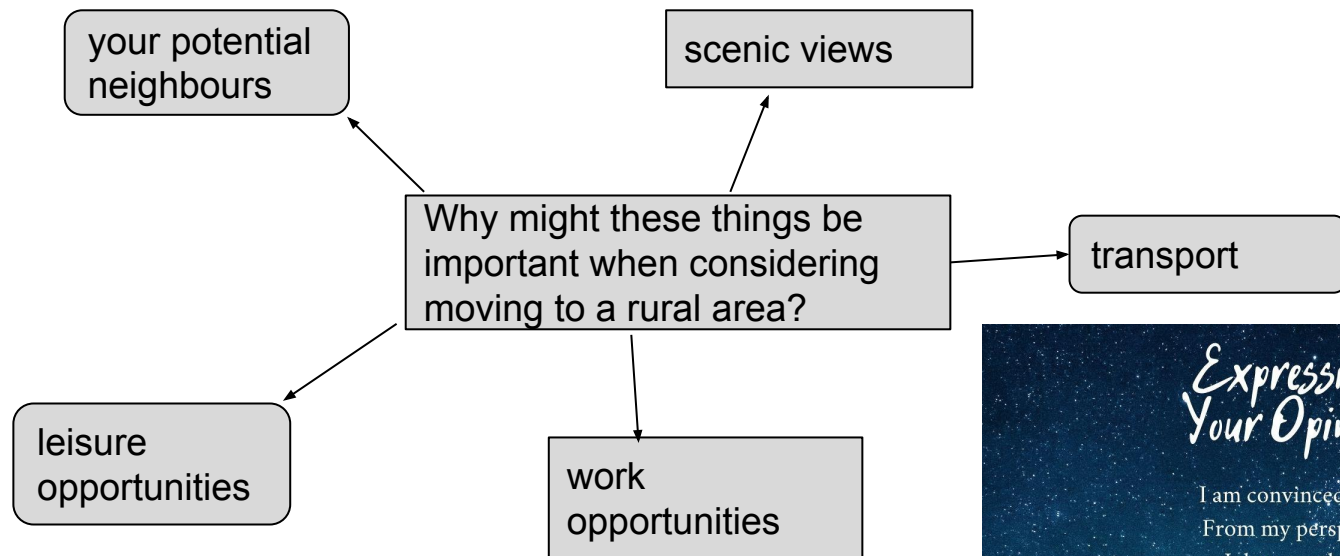

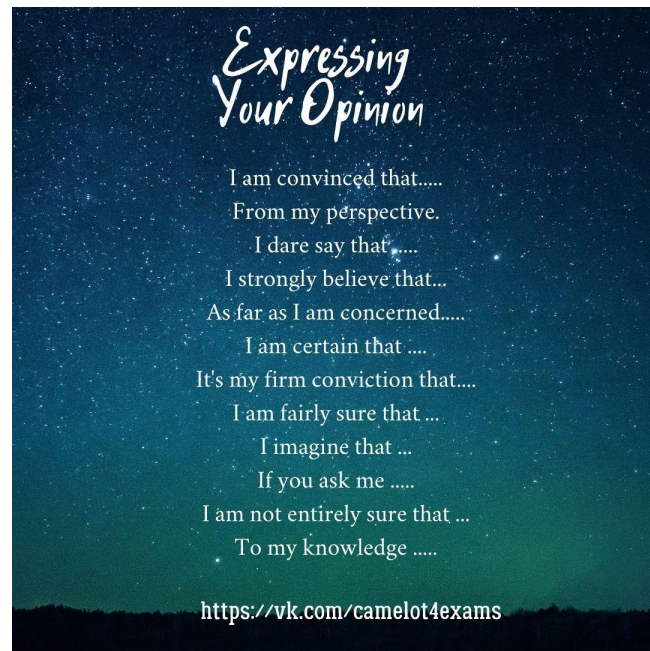
