# • *History of tartan*

*The oldest piece of tartan was found near the Scottish city of Falkirk. This fabric, about 1700 years old, is very different from the modern multi-colored tartans: it is made of unpainted sheep's wool - light and dark.*



# • *National clothes*



*Kilt - the subject of men's Scottish national clothing, traditional clothing of the Highlanders of Scotland. Kilt is a piece of cloth wrapped around the waist.*
