Getting a higher education in the field of medicine is a decisive step in the life of every applicant, because training in medical fields is one of the most difficult and responsible. Every year it becomes popular to receive medical education abroad, for reasons such as the quality of education, the latest technologies, practice and prospects for better employment. I want to tell you more about getting a medical education in Poland.





Medical universities in Poland are high-quality European education. Great emphasis is placed on practical skills, medical universities are equipped with the latest laboratories and devices, qualified teaching staff. A graduate of medicine has broad prospects for getting a job, both in Poland and abroad.



For admission to the State Medical University of Poland, it is necessary to pass entrance exams in chemistry, biology, physics, mathematics – each medical university independently makes a list. For applicants on a paid basis, it is enough to submit a package of documents to the university and pass an interview.





The training is conducted in Polish and/or English, so you will need language certificates of level B1-B2.

Foreign applicants have three ways of entering Polish universities: According to the Pole's Card - having proved Polish origin and received a Pole's Card, a foreigner enters a medical university on an equal basis with Polish citizens, that is, passes exams in chemistry, physics, biology in Polish and is trained for free; According to the scholarship program - entrance exams are taken at the consulate or Embassy of Poland , those who have passed the tests are given a referral to the first or zero course of a medical university for free training; For paid tuition - applicants provide a school certificate and pass a simple interview.







## TOPS OF MEDICAL UNIVERSITIES IN POLAND

1. Warsaw University of Medicine is considered the largest medical school in Poland, offering 17 curricula in Polish and 3 (dentistry, pharmacology, scientific research) in English. University services organize medical practice and employment abroad or in Poland.





2. Lodz University of Medicine cooperates with well-known medical universities of the world (King's College in London, University of Geneva)

3. Silesian Medical University in the city of Katowice is distinguished by a serious innovative base for studying. Scientific and student exchange, participation in practice abroad.









4. Gdansk Medical University has its own clinical hospitals and an Invasive Medicine Center, where the most complex operations are performed. The University conducts training in 15 academic programs in Polish and English.





5. Lublin Medical University offers higher medical education in master's and doctoral programs at 4 faculties. Agreements on interuniversity exchange and internship have been concluded with American and European clinics, university students also participate in the latest scientific research and development – for example, in a project on the use of robotics to help elderly people with dementia.
